I prologue	We prologue
You prologue	You prologue
He/She/It prologues	They prologue

Prologue in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am prologuing	We are prologuing
You are prologuing	You are prologuing
He/She/It is prologuing	They are prologuing

Prologue in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have prologued	We have prologued
You have prologued	You have prologued
He/She/It has prologued	They have prologued

Prologue in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been prologuing	We have been prologuing
You have been prologuing	You have been prologuing
He/She/It has been prologuing	They have been prologuing

Prologue in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

You prologued	You prologued
He/She/It prologued	They prologued

He/She/It had been prologuing	They had been prologuing

You will prologue	You will prologue
He/She/It will prologue	They will prologue

You will be prologuing	You will be prologuing
He/She/It will be prologuing	They will be prologuing
