Infinitive	<b>to prove</b>
Present Tense	<b>prove / proves</b>
Past Tense	<b>proved or prove</b>
Present Participle	<b>prooving</b>
Past Participle	<b>proved or prooven</b>

## Conjugate Prove

**Proove in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **prove**                  We **prove**  
You **prove**              You **prove**  
He/She/It **proves**    They **prove**

**Prove in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **am proving**            We **are proving**  
You **are proving**        You **are proving**  
He/She/It **is proving**    They **are proving**

**Prove in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular                                                  Plural**

I **have proved or proven**                  We **have proved or proven**  
You **have proved or proven**              You **have proved or proven**  
He/She/It **has proved or proven**        They **have proved or proven**

**Prove in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular                                                  Plural**

I **have been proving**                      We **have been proving**  
You **have been proving**                  You **have been proving**  
He/She/It **has been proving**            They **have been proving**

**Prove in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular                                                  Plural**

I **proved or prove**                      We **proved or prove**  
You **proved or prove**                  You **proved or prove**  
He/She/It **proved or prove**            They **proved or prove**

**Prove in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

I was proving                      We were proving  
You were proving                You were proving  
He/She/It was proving        They were proving

**Prove in Past Perfect Tense**

I had proved or proven            We had proved or proven  
You had proved or proven        You had proved or proven  
He/She/It had proved or proven    They had proved or proven

**Prove in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I had been proving                We had been proving  
You had been proving              You had been proving  
He/She/It had been proving        They had been proving

I will prove                      We will prove  
You will prove                    You will prove  
He/She/It will prove            They will prove

I will be proving                  We will be proving  
You will be proving                You will be proving  
He/She/It will be proving        They will be proving

**I will have proved or proven**

**We will have proved or proven**

**You will have proved or proven**

**He/She/It will have proved or proven** **They will have proved or proven**

**We will have been proving**

**You will have been proving**
