## Associations of "Props" (30 Words)

<b>apparatus</b>	A collection of notes, variant readings, and other matter accompanying a printed text. <i>The <b>apparatus</b> of government.</i>
<b>appliance</b>	Durable goods for home or office use. <i>Three fire <b>appliances</b> were rushed to the scene.</i>
<a href="#">axe</a>	Cut or strike with an axe especially violently or destructively. <i>Thirty staff are facing the <b>axe</b> at the Royal Infirmary.</i>
<b>device</b>	Any ornamental pattern or design (as in embroidery). <i>The <b>device</b> is small enough to wear on your wrist.</i>
<a href="#">drill</a>	Produce a hole in something by or as if by boring with a drill. <i>A sergeant was <b>drilling</b> new recruits.</i>
<b>equipment</b>	The process of supplying someone or something with necessary equipment. <i>A gym with all the latest <b>equipment</b>.</i>
<b>extrude</b>	Form or shape by forcing through an opening. <i><b>Extruded</b> and die cast aluminium.</i>
<b>flashing</b>	Brief, sudden, and intermittent bursts of bright light. <i>The <b>flashings</b> of pain were a warning.</i>
<b>gadget</b>	A small mechanical or electronic device or tool, especially an ingenious or novel one. <i>A variety of kitchen <b>gadgets</b>.</i>
<a href="#">gear</a>	Design or adjust the gears in a machine to give a specified speed or power output. <i>They <b>gear</b> workouts to your specific needs.</i>
<a href="#">instrument</a>	Write an instrumental score for. <i>Engineers have <b>instrumented</b> rockets to study the upper atmosphere.</i>
<a href="#">jarring</a>	Causing a physical shock, jolt, or vibration. <i>The telephone struck a <b>jarring</b> note in those Renaissance surroundings.</i>

<b>juggling</b>	The act of rearranging things to give a misleading impression.
<b>kit</b>	Young of any of various fur-bearing animals. <i>An aircraft <b>kit</b>.</i>
<b>lewis</b>	United States explorer and soldier who lead led an expedition from St. Louis to the mouth of the Columbia River (1774-1809).
<b>magic</b>	Move change or create by or as if by magic. <i>Confidence is the <b>magic</b> ingredient needed to spark recovery.</i>
<b>mechanism</b>	The technical aspects of doing something. <i>He determined unique <b>mechanisms</b> for the photochemical reactions.</i>
<b>movie</b>	A form of entertainment that enacts a story by sound and a sequence of images giving the illusion of continuous movement. <i>They went to a <b>movie</b> every Saturday night.</i>
<b>paintbrush</b>	A brush for applying paint.
<b>palette</b>	The range or variety of tonal or instrumental colour in a musical piece. <i>He commands the sort of tonal <b>palette</b> which this music needs.</i>
<b>paraphernalia</b>	Miscellaneous articles, especially the equipment needed for a particular activity. <i>Drills saws and other <b>paraphernalia</b> necessary for home improvements.</i>
<b>polisher</b>	A power tool used to buff surfaces.
<b>screen</b>	Separate something from something else with or as if with a screen. <i>A branch whipped across the <b>screen</b> and tore off one of the wipers.</i>
<b>smith</b>	Rhodesian statesman who declared independence of Zimbabwe from Great Britain (born in 1919). <i>Tin bronze was cast into ingots before being <b>smithed</b> into bracelets.</i>
<b>sprinkler</b>	A device that sprays water.
<b>tackle</b>	Make determined efforts to deal with (a problem or difficult task). <i>Fishing <b>tackle</b>.</i>
<b>tool</b>	A small stamp or roller used to make a tooled design. <i>They were <b>tooled</b> up with baseball bats.</i>
<b>utensil</b>	An implement for practical use (especially in a household). <i>Kitchen <b>utensils</b>.</i>
<b>utilization</b>	The state of having been made use of. <i>The rate of <b>utilization</b>.</i>
<b>widget</b>	A small gadget or mechanical device, especially one whose name is unknown or unspecified.
