| apparatus | A collection of notes, variant readings, and other matter accompanying a printed text. <i>The apparatus of government.</i> |
| appliance | Durable goods for home or office use. <i>Three fire appliances were rushed to the scene.</i> |
| axe | Cut or strike with an axe especially violently or destructively. <i>Thirty staff are facing the axe at the Royal Infirmary.</i> |
| device | Any ornamental pattern or design (as in embroidery). <i>The device is small enough to wear on your wrist.</i> |
| drill | Produce a hole in something by or as if by boring with a drill. <i>A sergeant was drilling new recruits.</i> |
| equipment | The process of supplying someone or something with necessary equipment. <i>A gym with all the latest equipment.</i> |
| extrude | Form or shape by forcing through an opening. <i>Extruded and die cast aluminium.</i> |
| flashing | Brief, sudden, and intermittent bursts of bright light. <i>The flashings of pain were a warning.</i> |
| gadget | A small mechanical or electronic device or tool, especially an ingenious or novel one. <i>A variety of kitchen gadgets.</i> |
| gear | Design or adjust the gears in a machine to give a specified speed or power output. <i>They gear workouts to your specific needs.</i> |
| instrument | Write an instrumental score for. <i>Engineers have instrumented rockets to study the upper atmosphere.</i> |
| jarring | Causing a physical shock, jolt, or vibration. <i>The telephone struck a jarring note in those Renaissance surroundings.</i> |

| <u>juggling</u> | The act of rearranging things to give a misleading impression. |
| kit | Young of any of various fur-bearing animals. <i>An aircraft kit.</i> |
| lewis | United States explorer and soldier who lead led an expedition from St. Louis to the mouth of the Columbia River (1774-1809). |
| magic | Move change or create by or as if by magic. <i>Confidence is the magic ingredient needed to spark recovery.</i> |
| <u>mechanism</u> | The technical aspects of doing something. <i>He determined unique mechanisms for the photochemical reactions.</i> |
| movie | A form of entertainment that enacts a story by sound and a sequence of images giving the illusion of continuous movement. <i>They went to a movie every Saturday night.</i> |
| paintbrush | A brush for applying paint. |
| palette | The range or variety of tonal or instrumental colour in a musical piece. <i>He commands the sort of tonal palette which this music needs.</i> |
| <u>paraphernalia</u> | Miscellaneous articles, especially the equipment needed for a particular activity. <i>Drills saws and other paraphernalia necessary for home improvements.</i> |
| polisher | A power tool used to buff surfaces. |
| <u>screen</u> | Separate something from something else with or as if with a screen. <i>A branch whipped across the screen and tore off one of the wipers.</i> |
| smith | Rhodesian statesman who declared independence of Zimbabwe from Great Britain (born in 1919). <i>Tin bronze was cast into ingots before being smithed into bracelets.</i> |
| sprinkler | A device that sprays water. |
| tackle | Make determined efforts to deal with (a problem or difficult task). <i>Fishing tackle.</i> |
| tool | A small stamp or roller used to make a tooled design. <i>They were tooled up with baseball bats.</i> |
| utensil | An implement for practical use (especially in a household). <i>Kitchen utensils.</i> |
| utilization | The state of having been made use of. <i>The rate of utilization.</i> |
| widget | A small gadget or mechanical device, especially one whose name is unknown or unspecified. |
