# **The Forms of Protest**

Infinitive	to protest
Present Tense	protest / protests
Past Tense	protested
Present Participle	protesting
Past Participle	protested

# **Conjugate Protest**

### **Protest in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I protest	We <b>protest</b>
You <b>protest</b>	You <b>protest</b>
He/She/It <b>protests</b>	They <b>protest</b>

# **Protest in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am protesting	We are protesting
You <b>are protesting</b>	You <b>are protesting</b>
He/She/It is protesting	They are protesting

### **Protest in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have protested	We have protested
You have protested	You have protested
He/She/It has protested	They have protested

## **Protest in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been protesting	We have been protesting
You have been protesting	You have been protesting
He/She/It has been protesting	They have been protesting

# **Protest in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I protested	We <b>protested</b>
You <b>protested</b>	You <b>protested</b>
He/She/It protested	They <b>protested</b>

### **Protest in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



SingularPluralI was protestingWe were protestingYou were protestingYou were protestingHe/She/It was protestingThey were protesting

### **Protest in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had protested	We had protested
You had protested	You had protested
He/She/It had protested	They had protested

### **Protest in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been protesting	We had been protesting
You <b>had been protesting</b>	You had been protesting
He/She/It had been protesting	They had been protesting

## **Protest in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will protest	We will protest
You <b>will protest</b>	You <b>will protest</b>
He/She/It will protest	They will protest

## **Protest in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be protesting	We will be protesting
You <b>will be protesting</b>	You will be protesting
He/She/It will be protesting	They will be protesting

#### **Protest in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have protested	We will have protested
You <b>will have protested</b>	You will have protested
He/She/It will have protested	They will have protested

# **Protest in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been protesting	We will have been protesting
You <b>will have been protesting</b>	You will have been protesting
He/She/It will have been protesting	They will have been protesting
