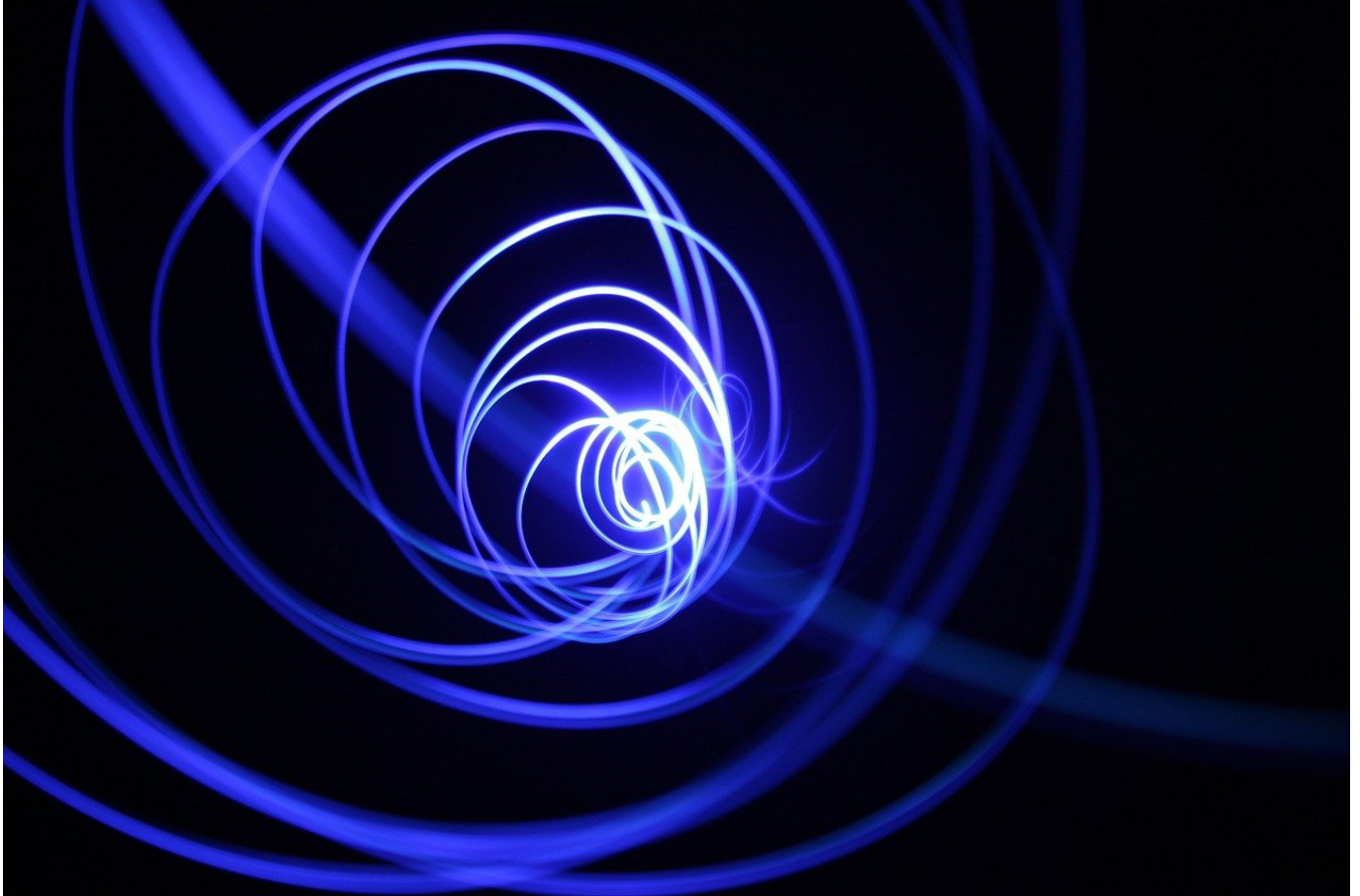

Definitions of "Psychedelic" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “psychedelic” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Producing distorted sensory perceptions and feelings or altered states of awareness or sometimes states resembling psychosis.*
- *Characterized by intense and distorted perceptions and hallucinations and feelings of euphoria or sometimes despair.*
- *(of music, especially rock) characterized by musical experimentation and drug-related lyrics.*
- *Having the vivid colors and bizarre patterns associated with psychedelic states.*
- *Having intense, vivid colours or a swirling abstract pattern.*
- *Relating to or denoting drugs (especially LSD) that produce hallucinations and apparent expansion of consciousness.*
- *(of a mental state) characterized by intense and distorted perceptions and hallucinations and feelings of euphoria or sometimes despair.*

brilliant	Clear and sharp and ringing. <i>A brilliant performance.</i>
chimerical	Being or relating to or like a chimera- Douglas Bush. <i>His Utopia is not a chimerical commonwealth but a practical improvement on what already exists.</i>
<u>ethereal</u>	Heavenly or spiritual. <i>Ethereal solution.</i>
<u>glowing</u>	Expressing great praise. <i>Glowing praise.</i>
illusionary	Marked by or producing illusion. <i>Illusionary stage effects.</i>
illusive	Based on or having the nature of an illusion. <i>An illusive haven.</i>

illusory	Based on or having the nature of an illusion. <i>She knew the safety of her room was illusory.</i>
<u>imaginary</u>	Not based on fact; existing only in the imagination. <i>Chris had imaginary conversations with her.</i>
phantasmagorical	Characterized by fantastic imagery and incongruous juxtapositions.
radiant	Of an appliance designed to emit radiant energy especially for cooking or heating. <i>Plants convert the radiant energy of the sun into chemical energy.</i>
rich	Marked by richness and fullness of flavor. <i>Dishes with wonderfully rich sauces.</i>
unreal	Lacking material form or substance unreal. <i>Many people have unreal expectations of marriage.</i>
unsubstantial	Lacking material form or substance; unreal. <i>A pretty if unsubstantial cubist composition.</i>
<u>vibrant</u>	Vigorous and animated. <i>His vibrant voice.</i>
<u>vivid</u>	(of a person or animal) lively and vigorous. <i>A vivid description.</i>
