fanatic A person motivated by irrational enthusiasm (as for a cause.

Religious **fanatic**s.

furious Marked by extreme anger.

**Furious** winds.

A disease or period of sickness affecting the body or mind.

He died after a long **illness**.

**incongruous** Lacking in harmony or compatibility or appropriateness.

A joke that was **incongruous** with polite conversation.

insane (of an action or quality) characterized or caused by madness.
