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Associations of "Punctuated" (30 Words)

amazement	The feeling that accompanies something extremely surprising. <i>She shook her head in amazement.</i>
ampere	A former unit of electric current slightly smaller than the SI ampere.
ampersand	A punctuation mark (&) used to represent conjunction (and).
apostrophe	Address to an absent or imaginary person.
astonishment	Great surprise. <i>He looked at me in astonishment.</i>
bookmark	A record of the address of a website, file, or other data made to enable quick access in future. <i>Fans will want to bookmark this site.</i>
comma	Anglewing butterfly with a comma shaped mark on the underside of each hind wing.
diacritical	Capable of distinguishing- S.F.Nadel.
dot	Scatter or intersperse like dots or studs. <i>You can turn a reel into a hornpipe by slowing it down a bit and dotting the quavers.</i>
embody	Form (people) into a body, especially for military purposes. <i>Nothing of the personality of the Spirit as embodied in Jesus will be lost.</i>
exclamation	An abrupt excited utterance. <i>An exclamation of amazement.</i>
grammar	A book on grammar. <i>It was not bad grammar just dialect.</i>
index	Provide with an index. <i>The list indexes theses under regional headings.</i>
indicant	A thing which indicates something. <i>Symptoms are the prime indicants of disease.</i>

indication	The act of indicating or pointing out by name. <i>Indications of strain.</i>
label	Attach a label to something. <i>The label modern is applied to many different kinds of architecture.</i>
mark	Make small marks into the surface of. <i>They re made from a woven surface which doesn t mark or tear.</i>
outcry	An exclamation or shout. <i>An outcry of spontaneous passion.</i>
punctuation	The use of certain marks to clarify meaning of written material by grouping words grammatically into sentences and clauses and phrases. <i>You will notice that no punctuation is used.</i>
quotation	The action of quoting from a text, speech, piece of music, or work of art. <i>A quotation from Mark Twain.</i>
signpost	Mark with a signpost as of a path. <i>Shorts remain the fashion signpost of summer s arrival.</i>
<u>slash</u>	Move or stir about violently. <i>A tyre was slashed on my car.</i>
<u>spelling</u>	The process or activity of writing or naming the letters of a word. <i>Her spelling was deplorable.</i>
<u>symbol</u>	Symbolize. <i>The chemical symbol for helium is He.</i>
<u>tag</u>	Attach a tag or label to. <i>You can easily add tags to photos en masse.</i>
<u>ticket</u>	Of a passenger be issued with a travel ticket. <i>The sports jacket had been ticketed at two hundred dollars.</i>
typographic	Relating to or occurring or used in typography. <i>A typographical error.</i>

weal	Mark with a weal. <i>She slapped his cheek and a bright red weal sprang up on it.</i>
word	The divine word of God the second person in the Trinity incarnate in Jesus. <i>He gave his word.</i>
