<a href="#">amazement</a>	The feeling that accompanies something extremely surprising. <i>She shook her head in <b>amazement</b>.</i>
<b>ampere</b>	A former unit of electric current slightly smaller than the SI ampere.
<b>ampersand</b>	A punctuation mark (&) used to represent conjunction (and).
<b>apostrophe</b>	Address to an absent or imaginary person.
<b>astonishment</b>	Great surprise. <i>He looked at me in <b>astonishment</b>.</i>
<a href="#">bookmark</a>	A record of the address of a website, file, or other data made to enable quick access in future. <i>Fans will want to <b>bookmark</b> this site.</i>
<b>comma</b>	Anglewing butterfly with a comma shaped mark on the underside of each hind wing.
<b>diacritical</b>	Capable of distinguishing- S.F.Nadel.
<b>dot</b>	Scatter or intersperse like dots or studs. <i>You can turn a reel into a hornpipe by slowing it down a bit and <b>dotting</b> the quavers.</i>
<a href="#">embody</a>	Form (people) into a body, especially for military purposes. <i>Nothing of the personality of the Spirit as embodied in Jesus will be lost.</i>
<a href="#">exclamation</a>	An abrupt excited utterance. <i>An <b>exclamation</b> of amazement.</i>
<b>grammar</b>	A book on grammar. <i>It was not bad <b>grammar</b> just dialect.</i>
<a href="#">index</a>	Provide with an index. <i>The list <b>indexes</b> theses under regional headings.</i>
<b>indicant</b>	A thing which indicates something. <i>Symptoms are the prime <b>indicants</b> of disease.</i>

<b>indication</b>	The act of indicating or pointing out by name. <i>Indications of strain.</i>
<b>label</b>	Attach a label to something. <i>The <b>label</b> modern is applied to many different kinds of architecture.</i>
<b>mark</b>	Make small marks into the surface of. <i>They re made from a woven surface which doesn t <b>mark</b> or tear.</i>
<b>outcry</b>	An exclamation or shout. <i>An <b>outcry</b> of spontaneous passion.</i>
<b>punctuation</b>	The use of certain marks to clarify meaning of written material by grouping words grammatically into sentences and clauses and phrases. <i>You will notice that no <b>punctuation</b> is used.</i>
<b>quotation</b>	The action of quoting from a text, speech, piece of music, or work of art. <i>A <b>quotation</b> from Mark Twain.</i>
<b>signpost</b>	Mark with a signpost as of a path. <i>Shorts remain the fashion <b>signpost</b> of summer s arrival.</i>
<u><b>slash</b></u>	Move or stir about violently. <i>A tyre was <b>slashed</b> on my car.</i>
<u><b>spelling</b></u>	The process or activity of writing or naming the letters of a word. <i>Her <b>spelling</b> was deplorable.</i>
<u><b>symbol</b></u>	Symbolize. <i>The chemical <b>symbol</b> for helium is He.</i>
<u><b>tag</b></u>	Attach a tag or label to. <i>You can easily add <b>tags</b> to photos en masse.</i>
<u><b>ticket</b></u>	Of a passenger be issued with a travel ticket. <i>The sports jacket had been <b>ticketed</b> at two hundred dollars.</i>
<b>typographic</b>	Relating to or occurring or used in typography. <i>A <b>typographical</b> error.</i>

<b>weal</b>	Mark with a weal. <i>She slapped his cheek and a bright red <b>weal</b> sprang up on it.</i>
