Infinitive	to punctulate
Present Tense	punctulate / punctulates
Past Tense	punctulated
Present Participle	punctulating
Past Participle	punctulated

# **Conjugate Punctulate**

## **Punctulate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>punctulate</b>	We <b>punctulate</b>
You <b>punctulate</b>	You <b>punctulate</b>
He/She/It punctulates	They <b>punctulate</b>

## **Punctulate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am punctulating	We are punctulating
You <b>are punctulating</b>	You are punctulating
He/She/It is punctulating	They are punctulating

#### **Punctulate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have punctulated	We have punctulated
You have punctulated	You have punctulated
He/She/It has punctulated	They have punctulated

### **Punctulate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been punctulating	We have been punctulating
You <b>have been punctulating</b>	You have been punctulating
He/She/It has been punctulating	They have been punctulating

## **Punctulate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I punctulated	We <b>punctulated</b>
You <b>punctulated</b>	You <b>punctulated</b>
He/She/It punctulated	They <b>punctulated</b>

### **Punctulate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was punctulating	We were punctulating
You were punctulating	You were punctulating
He/She/It was punctulating	They were punctulating

#### **Punctulate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had punctulated	We had punctulated
You had punctulated	You had punctulated
He/She/It had punctulated	They had punctulated

#### **Punctulate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been punctulating	We had been punctulating
You had been punctulating	You had been punctulating
He/She/It had been punctulating	They had been punctulating

## **Punctulate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will punctulate	We will punctulate
You <b>will punctulate</b>	You <b>will punctulate</b>
He/She/It will punctulate	They will punctulate

## **Punctulate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be punctulating	We will be punctulating
You <b>will be punctulating</b>	You will be punctulating
He/She/It will be punctulating	They will be punctulating

### **Punctulate in Future Perfect Tense**

#### **Punctulate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been punctulating	We will have been punctulating
You <b>will have been punctulating</b>	You will have been punctulating
He/She/It will have been punctulating	They will have been punctulating
