blameless	Innocent of wrongdoing. <i>Has lived a blameless life.</i>
blizzard	A severe snowstorm with high winds. <i>A blizzard of lawsuits.</i>
chaste	Abstaining from extramarital, or from all, sexual intercourse. <i>A chaste consoling embrace.</i>
clean	Clean one's body or parts thereof as by washing. <i>A clean sweep.</i>
cloud	Make overcast or cloudy. <i>The only cloud on the horizon was the possibility of dissent by the French.</i>
covered	Overlaid or spread or topped with or enclosed within something; sometimes used as a combining form. <i>Women with covered faces.</i>
flawless	Without a flaw. <i>Her smooth flawless skin.</i>
hail	Hail falls. <i>It hailed so hard we had to stop.</i>
immaculate	Uniformly coloured without spots or other marks. <i>An immaculate safety record.</i>
immiscible	Incapable of mixing. <i>Benzene is immiscible with water.</i>
impeccable	Not capable of sin. <i>Speaks impeccable French.</i>
innocence	The quality of innocent naivete. <i>The trial established his innocence.</i>

innocent	A person involved by chance in a situation, especially a victim of crime or war. <i>Innocent of literary merit.</i>
lowering	The act of causing to become less. <i>The painting depicts the lowering of the Count's body into his tomb.</i>
precipitation	The quantity of water falling to earth at a specific place within a specified period of time. <i>Cora was already regretting her precipitation.</i>
<u>pristine</u>	Immaculately clean and unused. <i>A pristine white shirt.</i>
purist	Someone who insists on great precision and correctness (especially in the use of words). <i>Purist fans of the original comic strip.</i>
<u>purity</u>	A woman's virtue or chastity. <i>The purity of our drinking water.</i>
sinless	Free from sin. <i>The sinless life of Christ.</i>
sleet	Sleet falls. <i>It was sleeting so hard we could barely see.</i>
snowy	Of the white color of snow. <i>A long snowy winter.</i>
<u>spotless</u>	Absolutely clean or pure; immaculate. <i>Spotless behaviour is seemingly the norm in his organization.</i>
uncontaminated	Not contaminated. <i>Uncontaminated air and food.</i>
unimpeachable	Not able to be doubted, questioned, or criticized; entirely trustworthy. <i>An unimpeachable reputation.</i>
unmixed	Not mixed. <i>Bold unmixed colours.</i>
unspotted	Without soil or spot or stain. <i>The network of avian enthusiasts ensures that no rarity goes unspotted.</i>
<u>untainted</u>	(of reputation) free from blemishes. <i>The island remains virtually untainted by commercialism.</i>
<u>virtuous</u>	Chaste (typically used of a woman). <i>She considered herself very virtuous because she neither drank nor smoked.</i>

white	The player of the white pieces in chess or draughts. <i>Lips white with terror.</i>
wintry	Characteristic of or occurring in winter. <i>Brown wintry grasses.</i>
