## Associations of "Put forth" (30 Words)

<a href="#">ambush</a>	Hunt quarry by stalking and ambushing. <i>Seven members of a patrol were killed in an <b>ambush</b>.</i>
<a href="#">backlash</a>	Come back to the originator of an action with an undesired effect. <i>A public <b>backlash</b> against racism.</i>
<b>bounce</b>	Hit something so that it bounces. <i>The ball <b>bounced</b> away and he chased it.</i>
<a href="#">bumpy</a>	Covered with or full of bumps. <i>The <b>bumpy</b> flight brought on a bout of airsickness.</i>
<a href="#">distant</a>	(of a sound) faint because far away. <i>A <b>distant</b> cousin.</i>
<b>embedded</b>	(of a microprocessor) designed and built as an integral part of a system or device. <i>Confused by the <b>embedded</b> Latin quotations.</i>
<a href="#">enclosed</a>	Closed in or surrounded or included within. <i>An <b>enclosed</b> yard.</i>
<a href="#">far</a>	Remote in time. <i>The house was not too <b>far</b> away.</i>
<a href="#">further</a>	To or at a greater distance in time or space farther is used more frequently than further in this physical sense. <i>The EU seems to have moved <b>further</b> away from the original aims.</i>
<b>hop</b>	The act of hopping jumping upward or forward especially on one foot. <i>Place the rabbit on the floor to have a <b>hop</b> around.</i>
<b>in</b>	A position of influence with someone powerful or famous. <i>Large shoulder pads are <b>in</b>.</i>
<b>included</b>	Enclosed in the same envelope or package. <i>All of Europe Britain <b>included</b>.</i>

<b>jump</b>	Cause to jump or leap. <i>She will make a sponsored <b>jump</b> at Thruxton Airfield.</i>
<b>lay</b>	Locate an episode in a play novel etc in a particular place. <i>A <b>lay</b> opinion as to the cause of the disease.</i>
<b>leap</b>	A thing to be leaped over or from. <i>A <b>leap</b> of 10 feet.</i>
<b>locate</b>	Establish oneself or one's business in a specified place. <i>They <b>locate</b> their policies in terms of wealth creation.</i>
<b>location</b>	A point or extent in space. <i>The <b>location</b> of new housing beyond the existing built up areas.</i>
<b>outside</b>	Functioning outside the boundaries or precincts of an organized unit. <i>The use of <b>outside</b> contractors will speed up the process.</i>
<b>place</b>	Score a goal by a place kick. <i>If you were in my <b>place</b> what would you do.</i>
<b>pounce</b>	A sudden swoop or spring. <i>As he watched a mink <b>pounced</b> on the vole.</i>
<b>rebound</b>	The act of securing possession of the rebounding basketball after a missed shot. <i>He proved that he can score and <b>rebound</b> as well as any of his peers.</i>
<b>recoil</b>	The action of recoiling. <i>If man upsets his planetary ecosystem it will automatically <b>recoil</b> upon him.</i>
<b>resurface</b>	Come back up to the surface of water. <i>He <b>resurfaced</b> under a false identity in Australia.</i>
<b>set</b>	Put or set seeds seedlings or plants into the ground. <i><b>Set</b> this poem to music.</i>
<b>situate</b>	Situated. <i>Amy is now comfortably <b>situated</b>.</i>
<b>situated</b>	Situated in a particular spot or position. <i>Nicely <b>situated</b> on a quiet riverbank.</i>
<b>skip</b>	A light bouncing step a skipping movement. <i>Marian <b>skipped</b> half heartedly through the book.</i>
<b>spring</b>	The ability to spring back strongly elasticity. <i>In <b>spring</b> the garden is a feast of blossom.</i>
<b>stash</b>	A quantity of an illegal drug, especially one kept for personal use. <i>One prisoner tried to swallow his <b>stash</b>.</i>
<b>upstage</b>	Move upstage forcing the other actors to turn away from the audience. <i>He was <b>upstage</b> with strangers.</i>
