ambush	Hunt quarry by stalking and ambushing. <i>Seven members of a patrol were killed in an ambush.</i>
backlash	Come back to the originator of an action with an undesired effect. <i>A public backlash against racism.</i>
bounce	Hit something so that it bounces. <i>The ball bounced away and he chased it.</i>
bumpy	Covered with or full of bumps. <i>The bumpy flight brought on a bout of airsickness.</i>
distant	(of a sound) faint because far away. <i>A distant cousin.</i>
embedded	(of a microprocessor) designed and built as an integral part of a system or device. <i>Confused by the embedded Latin quotations.</i>
enclosed	Closed in or surrounded or included within. <i>An enclosed yard.</i>
far	Remote in time. <i>The house was not too far away.</i>
further	To or at a greater distance in time or space farther is used more frequently than further in this physical sense. <i>The EU seems to have moved further away from the original aims.</i>
hop	The act of hopping jumping upward or forward especially on one foot. <i>Place the rabbit on the floor to have a hop around.</i>
in	A position of influence with someone powerful or famous. <i>Large shoulder pads are in.</i>
included	Enclosed in the same envelope or package. <i>All of Europe Britain included.</i>

jump	Cause to jump or leap. <i>She will make a sponsored jump at Thruxton Airfield.</i>
lay	Locate an episode in a play novel etc in a particular place. <i>A lay opinion as to the cause of the disease.</i>
leap	A thing to be leaped over or from. <i>A leap of 10 feet.</i>
locate	Establish oneself or one's business in a specified place. <i>They locate their policies in terms of wealth creation.</i>
location	A point or extent in space. <i>The location of new housing beyond the existing built up areas.</i>
outside	Functioning outside the boundaries or precincts of an organized unit. <i>The use of outside contractors will speed up the process.</i>
place	Score a goal by a place kick. <i>If you were in my place what would you do.</i>
pounce	A sudden swoop or spring. <i>As he watched a mink pounced on the vole.</i>
rebound	The act of securing possession of the rebounding basketball after a missed shot. <i>He proved that he can score and rebound as well as any of his peers.</i>
recoil	The action of recoiling. <i>If man upsets his planetary ecosystem it will automatically recoil upon him.</i>
resurface	Come back up to the surface of water. <i>He resurfaced under a false identity in Australia.</i>
set	Put or set seeds seedlings or plants into the ground. <i>Set this poem to music.</i>
situate	Situated. <i>Amy is now comfortably situated.</i>
situated	Situated in a particular spot or position. <i>Nicely situated on a quiet riverbank.</i>
skip	A light bouncing step a skipping movement. <i>Marian skipped half heartedly through the book.</i>
spring	The ability to spring back strongly elasticity. <i>In spring the garden is a feast of blossom.</i>
stash	A quantity of an illegal drug, especially one kept for personal use. <i>One prisoner tried to swallow his stash.</i>
upstage	Move upstage forcing the other actors to turn away from the audience. <i>He was upstage with strangers.</i>
