absentee	A person who is expected or required to be present at a place or event but is not. <i>Absentee pupils.</i>
away	An away match or win. <i>The wedding is only weeks away.</i>
by	So as to go past. <i>A car flashed by on the other side of the road.</i>
depart	Leave (one's job). <i>A contingent was departing from Cairo.</i>
distant	Not paying attention; remote. <i>Distant events.</i>
embedded	(of a journalist) attached to a military unit during a conflict. <i>A gold ring with nine embedded stones.</i>
enclosed	Surrounded or closed off on all sides. <i>An enclosed porch.</i>
exclude	Deny (someone) access to a place, group, or privilege. <i>The public were excluded from the board meeting.</i>
exhale	Breathe out. <i>The chimney exhales a thick smoke.</i>
facade	A deceptive outward appearance. <i>Her flawless public facade masked private despair.</i>
far	Located at a great distance in time or space or degree. <i>The far right.</i>
furnished	(of accommodation) available to be rented with furniture. <i>A full sized fully furnished apartment.</i>
habitable	Suitable or good enough to live in. <i>The house should be habitable by Christmas.</i>

home	At or to or in the direction of one's home or family. <i>I don't have your home address.</i>
household	The establishment and affairs of a royal household. <i>It was a good Christian household.</i>
in	Holding office. <i>The in thing to do.</i>
included	Enclosed in the same envelope or package. <i>All of Europe Britain included.</i>
indoor	Relating to sports played indoors. <i>An indoor setting.</i>
lay	The laying of eggs or the period during which they are laid. <i>Roll the carpet against the lay of the nap.</i>
leave	Leave or give by will after one's death. <i>A ten day's leave to visit his mother.</i>
place	Put into a certain place or abstract location. <i>He put the lamp back in its place.</i>
porch	A covered shelter projecting in front of the entrance of a building. <i>The north porch of Hereford Cathedral.</i>
respire	Breathe. <i>A country where fresh air seems impossible to respire.</i>
set	Set down according to a plan. <i>The subjects set led them to solve problems the familiar way and to overlook the simpler solution.</i>
situate	Situated. <i>Amy is now comfortably situated.</i>
stray	An animal that has strayed especially a domestic animal. <i>The military arrested anyone who strayed into the exclusion zone.</i>
supine	Offering no resistance- Theodore Roosevelt. <i>No other colony showed such supine selfish helplessness in allowing her own border citizens to be mercilessly harried.</i>
threshold	A strip of wood or stone forming the bottom of a doorway and crossed in entering a house or room. <i>The inheritance tax threshold.</i>
treetop	The uppermost part of a tree.
upstage	Move upstage forcing the other actors to turn away from the audience. <i>Hamlet turns to face upstage.</i>
