## Associations of "Put out" (30 Words)

<b>absentee</b>	A person who is expected or required to be present at a place or event but is not. <i><b>Absentee</b> pupils.</i>
<a href="#">away</a>	An away match or win. <i>The wedding is only weeks <b>away</b>.</i>
<b>by</b>	So as to go past. <i>A car flashed <b>by</b> on the other side of the road.</i>
<a href="#">depart</a>	Leave (one's job). <i>A contingent was <b>departing</b> from Cairo.</i>
<a href="#">distant</a>	Not paying attention; remote. <i><b>Distant</b> events.</i>
<b>embedded</b>	(of a journalist) attached to a military unit during a conflict. <i>A gold ring with nine <b>embedded</b> stones.</i>
<a href="#">enclosed</a>	Surrounded or closed off on all sides. <i>An <b>enclosed</b> porch.</i>
<b>exclude</b>	Deny (someone) access to a place, group, or privilege. <i>The public were <b>excluded</b> from the board meeting.</i>
<a href="#">exhale</a>	Breathe out. <i>The chimney <b>exhales</b> a thick smoke.</i>
<a href="#">facade</a>	A deceptive outward appearance. <i>Her flawless public <b>facade</b> masked private despair.</i>
<a href="#">far</a>	Located at a great distance in time or space or degree. <i>The <b>far</b> right.</i>
<b>furnished</b>	(of accommodation) available to be rented with furniture. <i>A full sized fully <b>furnished</b> apartment.</i>
<b>habitable</b>	Suitable or good enough to live in. <i>The house should be <b>habitable</b> by Christmas.</i>

<b>home</b>	At or to or in the direction of one's home or family. <i>I don't have your <b>home</b> address.</i>
<b>household</b>	The establishment and affairs of a royal household. <i>It was a good Christian <b>household</b>.</i>
<b>in</b>	Holding office. <i>The <b>in</b> thing to do.</i>
<b>included</b>	Enclosed in the same envelope or package. <i>All of Europe Britain <b>included</b>.</i>
<b>indoor</b>	Relating to sports played indoors. <i>An <b>indoor</b> setting.</i>
<b>lay</b>	The laying of eggs or the period during which they are laid. <i>Roll the carpet against the <b>lay</b> of the nap.</i>
<b>leave</b>	Leave or give by will after one's death. <i>A ten day's <b>leave</b> to visit his mother.</i>
<b>place</b>	Put into a certain place or abstract location. <i>He put the lamp back in its <b>place</b>.</i>
<b>porch</b>	A covered shelter projecting in front of the entrance of a building. <i>The north <b>porch</b> of Hereford Cathedral.</i>
<b>respire</b>	Breathe. <i>A country where fresh air seems impossible to <b>respire</b>.</i>
<b>set</b>	Set down according to a plan. <i>The subjects <b>set</b> led them to solve problems the familiar way and to overlook the simpler solution.</i>
<b>situate</b>	Situated. <i>Amy is now comfortably <b>situated</b>.</i>
<b>stray</b>	An animal that has strayed especially a domestic animal. <i>The military arrested anyone who <b>strayed</b> into the exclusion zone.</i>
<b>supine</b>	Offering no resistance- Theodore Roosevelt. <i>No other colony showed such <b>supine</b> selfish helplessness in allowing her own border citizens to be mercilessly harried.</i>
<b>threshold</b>	A strip of wood or stone forming the bottom of a doorway and crossed in entering a house or room. <i>The inheritance tax <b>threshold</b>.</i>
<b>treetop</b>	The uppermost part of a tree.
<b>upstage</b>	Move upstage forcing the other actors to turn away from the audience. <i>Hamlet turns to face <b>upstage</b>.</i>
