<b><a href="#">enclosed</a></b>	Closed in or surrounded or included within. <i>A dark <b>enclosed</b> space.</i>
<b><a href="#">hoard</a></b>	Accumulate (money or valued objects) and hide or store away. <i>He came back to rescue his little <b>hoard</b> of gold.</i>
<b>hole</b>	Make holes in. <i>Stephen lost the first three <b>holes</b> to Eric.</i>
<b>in</b>	A state in midwestern United States. <i>We were locked <b>in</b>.</i>
<b>included</b>	Enclosed in the same envelope or package. <i>All of Europe Britain <b>included</b>.</i>
<b>infusion</b>	The process of preparing an infusion. <i>The <b>infusion</b> of 6 3 million for improvements.</i>
<b>injection</b>	The action of injecting. <i>A morphine <b>injection</b>.</i>

<b>intravenous</b>	Within or by means of a vein. An <b>intravenous</b> inflammation.
<b>involved</b>	Emotionally involved. The difficulties in which the question is <b>involved</b> .
<b>jell</b>	(of a project or idea) take a definite form or begin to work well. We went out there and tried to win but we just didn't <b>jell</b> .
<b>lay</b>	The laying of eggs or the period during which they are laid. <b>Lay</b> the patient carefully onto the bed.
<b>match</b>	Make equal uniform corresponding or matching. They were no <b>match</b> for the mercenaries.
<b>penetrable</b>	Capable of being penetrated. <b>Penetrable</b> defenses.
<b>permeable</b>	(of a material or membrane) allowing liquids or gases to pass through it. <b>Permeable</b> sandy soils.
<b>place</b>	Identify the location or place of. Accurate reportage takes second <b>place</b> to lurid detail.
<b>porosity</b>	The quality or degree of having minute spaces or holes through which liquid or air may pass. Improve your soil's <b>porosity</b> by digging in some compost when you plant.
<b>posit</b>	Logic a proposition that is accepted as true in order to provide a basis for logical reasoning. He <b>posited</b> three basic laws of nature.
<b>set</b>	Put or set seeds seedlings or plants into the ground. A bracelet <b>set</b> with emeralds.
<b>situate</b>	Situated. The petty sessions area in which it is <b>situate</b> .
<b>situated</b>	Situated in a particular spot or position. Nicely <b>situated</b> on a quiet riverbank.
<b>stash</b>	A secret store of valuables or money. One prisoner tried to swallow his <b>stash</b> .
<b>supine</b>	Lying face upward. The government was <b>supine</b> in the face of racial injustice.
<b>transcend</b>	Surpass (a person or achievement). He doubts that he will ever <b>transcend</b> Shakespeare.
<b>welder</b>	A person who welds metal. He worked as a <b>welder</b> in a steel factory.
