### **Definitions of "Puzzled" as an adjective**

- *Filled with bewilderment.*
- *Unable to understand; perplexed.*



### **Synonyms of "Puzzled" as an adjective (2 Words)**

**nonplused** Filled with bewilderment.

**nonplussed** So surprised and confused that one is unsure how to react.  
*Henry looked completely **nonplussed**.*



## Usage Examples of "Puzzled" as an adjective

- *Puzzled that she left without saying goodbye.*
- *She looked puzzled and angry with him.*
- *The questioners were met with puzzled looks.*





## Associations of "Puzzled" (30 Words)

<b><u>amaze</u></b>	Be a mystery or bewildering to. <i>He has been <b>amazed</b> by the quality of the employees at the bank.</i>
<b>amazed</b>	Greatly surprised; astonished. <i>Chandler looked absolutely <b>amazed</b>.</i>
<b>astonish</b>	Affect with wonder. <i>It <b>astonished</b> her that he was so anxious.</i>
<b><u>astonished</u></b>	Greatly surprised or impressed; amazed. <i>He was <b>astonished</b> at the change in him.</i>
<b><u>astonishing</u></b>	Surprising greatly. <i>Such an enormous response was <b>astonishing</b>.</i>
<b>astound</b>	Shock or greatly surprise. <i>Her bluntness <b>astounded</b> him.</i>
<b>astounded</b>	Filled with the emotional impact of overwhelming surprise or shock. <i><b>Astounded</b> viewers wept at the pictures from the Oklahoma City bombing.</i>
<b><u>astounding</u></b>	So surprisingly impressive as to stun or overwhelm. <i>The summit offers <b>astounding</b> views.</i>

<b>bemuse</b>	Cause to be confused emotionally. <i>He was <b>bemused</b> by what was happening.</i>
<b><u>bewilder</u></b>	Be a mystery or bewildering to. <i>His reaction had <b>bewildered</b> her.</i>
<b><u>blank</u></b>	Cut a metal blank. <i><b>Blank</b> tax return forms.</i>
<b><u>daze</u></b>	Overcome as with astonishment or disbelief. <i>He was walking around in a <b>daze</b>.</i>
<b>dumbfound</b>	Greatly astonish or amaze. <i>I was <b>dumbfounded</b> by the low prices there.</i>
<b><u>flabbergasted</u></b>	As if struck dumb with astonishment and surprise. <i>The <b>flabbergasted</b> aldermen were speechless.</i>
<b>incredulity</b>	The state of being unwilling or unable to believe something. <i>He stared down the street in <b>incredulity</b>.</i>
<b><u>perplexed</u></b>	Completely baffled; very puzzled. <i>She gave him a <b>perplexed</b> look.</i>
<b>predicament</b>	A situation from which extrication is difficult especially an unpleasant or trying one. <i>Finds himself in a most awkward <b>predicament</b>.</i>
<b><u>quandary</u></b>	A situation from which extrication is difficult especially an unpleasant or trying one. <i>A legal <b>quandary</b>.</i>
<b>questioning</b>	(of a look) suggesting that information is sought. <i>This situation should prompt <b>questioning</b>.</i>
<b>quizzical</b>	Playfully vexing (especially by ridicule). <i>She gave me a <b>quizzical</b> look.</i>
<b>serendipity</b>	The occurrence and development of events by chance in a happy or beneficial way. <i>A fortunate stroke of <b>serendipity</b>.</i>
<b>shock</b>	Affect with physiological shock or with an electric shock. <i><b>Shocked</b> onlookers watched as detectives broke into the pub.</i>
<b><u>shocked</u></b>	Struck with fear, dread, or consternation.
<b><u>staggering</u></b>	So surprisingly impressive as to stun or overwhelm. <i>The <b>staggering</b> bills for maintenance and repair.</i>
<b><u>stalemate</u></b>	Bring to or cause to reach stalemate. <i>Last time I played him it ended up in <b>stalemate</b>.</i>

<b><u>stuck</u></b>	Baffled. <i>This problem has me completely <b>stuck</b>.</i>
<b>stupefy</b>	Make senseless or dizzy by or as if by a blow. <i>The offence of administering drugs to a woman with intent to <b>stupefy</b> her.</i>
<b>surprise</b>	Cause to be surprised. <i>Joe was <b>surprised</b> that he enjoyed the journey.</i>
<b>surprised</b>	Feeling or showing surprise. <i>There was a <b>surprised</b> silence.</i>
<b><u>wondering</u></b>	Characterized by or expressive of a desire to know something; curious. <i>Unsure where she was leading to I cast her a <b>wondering</b> look.</i>
