Usage Examples of "Puzzled" as an adjective

- Puzzled that she left without saying goodbye.
- $\bullet \ \textit{She looked puzzled and angry with him}.$
- The questioners were met with puzzled looks.





Associations of "Puzzled" (30 Words)

Be a mystery or bewildering to. amaze

He has been **amaze**d by the quality of the employees at the bank.

Greatly surprised; astonished. amazed

Chandler looked absolutely amazed.

Affect with wonder. astonish

It **astonish**ed her that he was so anxious.

Greatly surprised or impressed; amazed.

astonished He was **astonished** at the change in him.

Surprising greatly. astonishing

Such an enormous response was astonishing.

Shock or greatly surprise. astound Her bluntness astounded him.

Filled with the emotional impact of overwhelming surprise or shock.

astounded **Astounded** viewers wept at the pictures from the Oklahoma City bombing.

So surprisingly impressive as to stun or overwhelm.

astounding The summit offers **astounding** views.



bemuse Cause to be confused emotionally.

He was **bemuse**d by what was happening.

bewilderBe a mystery or bewildering to.

His reaction had bewildered her.

blank Cut a metal blank.

Blank tax return forms.

daze Overcome as with astonishment or disbelief.

He was walking around in a **daze**.

dumbfound Greatly astonish or amaze.

I was dumbfounded by the low prices there.

flabbergasted The Gabbergasted added to the state of the

The **flabbergasted** aldermen were speechless.

incredulity The state of being unwilling or unable to believe something.

He stared down the street in **incredulity**.

Completely baffled; very puzzled.

She gave him a **perplexed** look.

A situation from which extrication is difficult especially an unpleasant or

predicament trying one.

Finds himself in a most awkward **predicament**.

quandary trying one.

A legal **quandary**.

quizzical Playfully vexing (especially by ridicule.

She gave me a **quizzical** look.

The occurrence and development of events by chance in a happy or

serendipity beneficial way.

A fortunate stroke of **serendipity**.

shock Affect with physiological shock or with an electric shock.

Shocked onlookers watched as detectives broke into the pub.

shocked Struck with fear, dread, or consternation.

So surprisingly impressive as to stun or overwhelm.

The **staggering** bills for maintenance and repair.

Bring to or cause to reach stalemate.

Last time I played him it ended up in **stalemate**.



stuck Baffled.

This problem has me completely **stuck**.

stupefyMake senseless or dizzy by or as if by a blow.

The offence of administering drugs to a woman with intent to **stupefy** her.

surprise Cause to be surprised.

Joe was **surprise**d that he enjoyed the journey.

surprised Feeling or showing surprise.

There was a **surprised** silence.

wondering Characterized by or expressive of a desire to know something; curious.

Unsure where she was leading to I cast her a wondering look.
