## The Forms of Quake

Infinitive	to quake
Present Tense	quake / quakes
Past Tense	quaked or (archaic) quoke or (obsolete) quook
Present Participle	quaking
Past Participle	quaked or (archaic) quoke or (obsolete) quook

# **Conjugate Quake**

#### **Quake in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>quake</b>	We <b>quake</b>
You <b>quake</b>	You <b>quake</b>
He/She/It <b>quakes</b>	They <b>quake</b>

#### **Quake in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>am quaking</b>	We <b>are quaking</b>
You <b>are quaking</b>	You <b>are quaking</b>
He/She/It is quaking	They are quaking

#### **Quake in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have quaked or (archaic) quoke or	We <b>have quaked or (archaic) quoke or</b>
(obsolete) quook	(obsolete) quook
You <b>have quaked or (archaic) quoke or</b>	You <b>have quaked or (archaic) quoke or</b>
(obsolete) quook	(obsolete) quook
He/She/It <b>has quaked or (archaic) quoke</b>	They <b>have quaked or (archaic) quoke or</b>
or (obsolete) quook	(obsolete) quook

### **Quake in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been quaking	We have been quaking
You <b>have been quaking</b>	You have been quaking
He/She/It has been quaking	They have been quaking

## **Quake in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I quaked or (archaic) quoke or (obsolete)	We <b>quaked or (archaic) quoke or</b>
quook	(obsolete) quook
You <b>quaked or (archaic) quoke or</b>	You <b>quaked or (archaic) quoke or</b>
(obsolete) quook	(obsolete) quook



(obsolete) quook

**Singular** He/She/It **quaked or (archaic) quoke or**  Plural

They quaked or (archaic) quoke or (obsolete) quook

#### **Quake in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I was quaking	We <b>were quaking</b>
You <b>were quaking</b>	You <b>were quaking</b>
He/She/It was quaking	They were quaking

#### **Quake in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had quaked or (archaic) quoke or	We had quaked or (archaic) quoke or
(obsolete) quook	(obsolete) quook
You <b>had quaked or (archaic) quoke or</b>	You <b>had quaked or (archaic) quoke or</b>
(obsolete) quook	(obsolete) quook
He/She/It had quaked or (archaic) quoke or (obsolete) quook	They <b>had quaked or (archaic) quoke or (obsolete) quook</b>

#### **Quake in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been quaking	We had been quaking
You <b>had been quaking</b>	You had been quaking
He/She/It had been quaking	They had been quaking

### **Quake in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>will quake</b>	We <b>will quake</b>
You <b>will quake</b>	You <b>will quake</b>
He/She/It will quake	They will quake



## **Quake in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be quaking	We <b>will be quaking</b>
You <b>will be quaking</b>	You <b>will be quaking</b>
He/She/It will be quaking	They will be quaking

### **Quake in Future Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have quaked or (archaic) quoke or	We <b>will have quaked or (archaic) quoke</b>
(obsolete) quook	or (obsolete) quook
You <b>will have quaked or (archaic) quoke</b>	You <b>will have quaked or (archaic) quoke</b>
or (obsolete) quook	or (obsolete) quook
He/She/It <b>will have quaked or (archaic)</b>	They <b>will have quaked or (archaic) quoke</b>
<b>quoke or (obsolete) quook</b>	or (obsolete) quook

### **Quake in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been quaking	We <b>will have been quaking</b>
You <b>will have been quaking</b>	You <b>will have been quaking</b>
He/She/It will have been quaking	They will have been quaking
