## Associations of "Qualitative" (30 Words)

<b>adipose</b>	Composed of animal fat. <i><b>Adipose</b> tissue constitutes the fat of meat.</i>
<b>byproduct</b>	A secondary and sometimes unexpected consequence.
<b>cloth</b>	A piece of cloth for cleaning or covering something e g a dishcloth or a tablecloth. <i>Has he given up all ideas of the <b>cloth</b>.</i>
<b>corporeal</b>	Affecting or characteristic of the body as opposed to the mind or spirit. <i>In Scotland goods includes all <b>corporeal</b> movables except money.</i>
<b>drapery</b>	Cloth, curtains, or clothing hanging in loose folds. <i>The hall of the school was hung with green <b>drapery</b>.</i>
<b>eaves</b>	The part of a roof that meets or overhangs the walls of a building. <i>Wild bees nest under the <b>eaves</b>.</i>
<b>fabric</b>	The basic structure of a society, culture, activity, etc. <i>Decay and neglect are slowly eating away at the building s <b>fabric</b>.</i>
<b>factor</b>	With numeral a sunscreen of the sun protection factor specified. <i>His father was chief <b>factor</b> for the Hudson s Bay Company.</i>
<b>felt</b>	Change texture so as to become matted and felt like. <i>A <b>felt</b> hat.</i>
<b>filling</b>	The act of filling something. <i>An informal British term for <b>filling</b> is stopping.</i>
<b>fluffy</b>	Of, like, or covered with fluff. <i><b>Fluffy</b> white clouds.</i>
<b>freon</b>	An aerosol propellant, refrigerant, or organic solvent consisting of one or more of a group of chlorofluorocarbons and related compounds.
<b>item</b>	Used to introduce each item in a list. <i>The <b>items</b> on the agenda.</i>

<b>lined</b>	Marked by lines or seams. <i>A sheet of <b>lined</b> paper.</i>
<b>lining</b>	The act of attaching an inside lining to a garment or curtain etc. <i>Leather gloves with fur <b>linings</b>.</i>
<b>material</b>	Having material or physical form or substance. <b>Material</b> needs.
<b>napkin</b>	A small piece of table linen that is used to wipe the mouth and to cover the lap in order to protect clothing. <i>She unfolded her <b>napkin</b> and put it on her lap.</i>
<b>nylon</b>	Stockings or tights made of nylon. <i>The tent is made of blue <b>nylon</b>.</i>
<b>packing</b>	A charge made when delivering goods to cover the cost of packing them. <i>2 plus postage and <b>packing</b>.</i>
<b>plastic</b>	Credit cards or other types of plastic card that can be used as money. <i>The writer is drawn to words as a <b>plastic</b> medium.</i>
<b>qualitatively</b>	With regard to the quality or qualities of something rather than its quantity. <i>Our results differ <b>qualitatively</b> from previous studies.</i>
<b>somatic</b>	Relating to the body, especially as distinct from the mind. <i>Patients completed a questionnaire about their <b>somatic</b> and psychological symptoms.</i>
<b>stratum</b>	A foundation or basis of something. <i>The plant will grow very rapidly and send out runners above the <b>stratum</b>.</i>
<b>textile</b>	Used by nudists in reference to non-nudists. <i>A fascinating range of pottery jewellery and <b>textiles</b>.</i>
<b>texture</b>	Give something a rough or uneven texture. <i>The wall had a smooth <b>texture</b>.</i>
<b>upholstery</b>	Soft, padded textile covering that is fixed to furniture such as armchairs and sofas. <i>Leather <b>upholstery</b>.</i>
<b>valance</b>	A protective panel screening the wheels of a vehicle.
<b>velvety</b>	Having a smooth, soft appearance, feel, or taste. <i>Robes of <b>velvety</b> black.</i>
<b>vinyl</b>	Synthetic resin or plastic consisting of polyvinyl chloride or a related polymer used for wallpapers and other covering materials and for records. <i>The <b>vinyl</b> is cut to size with a craft knife.</i>
