<b>oaken</b>	Consisting of or made of wood of the oak tree. <i>The old <b>oaken</b> bucket.</i>
<b>oddy</b>	A strange attitude or habit. <i>She was regarded as a bit of an <b>oddy</b>.</i>
<b>peculiarity</b>	The quality of being peculiar. <i>His essays characterized decency as a British <b>peculiarity</b>.</i>
<b>pistol</b>	Shoot someone with a pistol. <i>When we first met he was a <b>pistol</b> full of ideals and a natural leader.</i>
<b>revolver</b>	A pistol with revolving chambers enabling several shots to be fired without reloading.

<b>workmanlike</b>	Showing efficient competence but not inspiration. <i>A steady <b>workmanlike</b> approach.</i>
<b>workmanship</b>	The degree of skill with which a product is made or a job done. <i>Cracks on the motorway were caused by poor <b>workmanship</b>.</i>
