abstractly	In abstract terms.
<u>clarification</u>	An interpretation that removes obstacles to understanding. <i>The professor s clarification helped her to understand the textbook.</i>
<u>clarify</u>	Make (a statement or situation) less confused and more comprehensible. <i>The report managed to clarify the government s position.</i>
define	Make clear the outline of; delineate. <i>The contract will seek to define the client s obligations.</i>
<u>depict</u>	Make a portrait of. <i>Youth is depicted as a time of vitality and good health.</i>
<u>depiction</u>	Representation by drawing or painting etc. <i>The painting s horrific depiction of war.</i>
<u>descriptive</u>	Of or relating to an approach to linguistic analysis that aims at the description of a language’s forms, structures and usage. <i>Descriptive grammar.</i>
dictionary	A reference book containing an alphabetical list of words with information about them. <i>The dictionary definition of smile.</i>
differentia	Distinguishing characteristics (especially in different species of a genus.
disambiguate	State unambiguously or remove ambiguities from. <i>Can you disambiguate this statement.</i>
<u>discrete</u>	Constituting a separate entity or part. <i>A government with three discrete divisions.</i>
distinct	(often followed by `from’) not alike; different in nature or quality. <i>Distinct fingerprints.</i>
<u>divide</u>	Find how many times (a number) contains another. <i>Divide the cake into three equal parts.</i>

<u>elucidate</u>	Make free from confusion or ambiguity; make clear. <i>Work such as theirs will help to elucidate this matter.</i>
example	A person or thing regarded in terms of their fitness to be imitated. <i>It is important that parents should set an example.</i>
expatiate	Speak or write in detail about. <i>She expatiated on working class novelists.</i>
explain	Be the cause of or motivating factor for. <i>He explained the situation.</i>
explicate	Analyse and develop (an idea or principle) in detail. <i>These essays seek to explicate and contextualize Kristeva s writings.</i>
<u>explicit</u>	Of a person stating something in an explicit manner. <i>The arrangement had not been made explicit.</i>
<u>exposition</u>	(music) the section of a movement (especially in sonata form) where the major musical themes first occur. <i>We would have understood the play better if there had been some initial exposition of the background.</i>
expository	Serving to expound or set forth. <i>An expository prologue.</i>
expound	Explain the meaning of (a literary or doctrinal work). <i>He declined to expound on his decision.</i>
instructions	A manual usually accompanying a technical device and explaining how to install or operate it.
<u>interpret</u>	Give an interpretation or rendition of. <i>The evidence is difficult to interpret.</i>
<u>interpretation</u>	The action of explaining the meaning of something. <i>The interpretation of data.</i>
mean	Mean or intend to express or convey. <i>I only meant to help you.</i>
rationale	(law) an explanation of the fundamental reasons (especially an explanation of the working of some device in terms of laws of nature). <i>He explained the rationale behind the change.</i>
separate	A separately printed article that originally appeared in a larger publication. <i>Police were trying to separate two rioting mobs.</i>
signification	The message that is intended or expressed or signified. <i>The signification of Chinese characters.</i>

specific

A medicine that has a mitigating effect on a specific disease.
*The differences between them can only be on the **specific** level.*
