<b>abstractly</b>	In abstract terms.
<b><u>clarification</u></b>	An interpretation that removes obstacles to understanding. <i>The professor s <b>clarification</b> helped her to understand the textbook.</i>
<b><u>clarify</u></b>	Make (a statement or situation) less confused and more comprehensible. <i>The report managed to <b>clarify</b> the government s position.</i>
<b>define</b>	Make clear the outline of; delineate. <i>The contract will seek to <b>define</b> the client s obligations.</i>
<b><u>depict</u></b>	Make a portrait of. <i>Youth is <b>depicted</b> as a time of vitality and good health.</i>
<b><u>depiction</u></b>	Representation by drawing or painting etc. <i>The painting s horrific <b>depiction</b> of war.</i>
<b><u>descriptive</u></b>	Of or relating to an approach to linguistic analysis that aims at the description of a language’s forms, structures and usage. <i><b>Descriptive</b> grammar.</i>
<b>dictionary</b>	A reference book containing an alphabetical list of words with information about them. <i>The <b>dictionary</b> definition of smile.</i>
<b>differentia</b>	Distinguishing characteristics (especially in different species of a genus.
<b>disambiguate</b>	State unambiguously or remove ambiguities from. <i>Can you <b>disambiguate</b> this statement.</i>
<b><u>discrete</u></b>	Constituting a separate entity or part. <i>A government with three <b>discrete</b> divisions.</i>
<b>distinct</b>	(often followed by `from’) not alike; different in nature or quality. <i><b>Distinct</b> fingerprints.</i>
<b><u>divide</u></b>	Find how many times (a number) contains another. <i><b>Divide</b> the cake into three equal parts.</i>

<b><u>elucidate</u></b>	Make free from confusion or ambiguity; make clear. <i>Work such as theirs will help to <b>elucidate</b> this matter.</i>
<b>example</b>	A person or thing regarded in terms of their fitness to be imitated. <i>It is important that parents should set an <b>example</b>.</i>
<b>expatiate</b>	Speak or write in detail about. <i>She <b>expatiated</b> on working class novelists.</i>
<b>explain</b>	Be the cause of or motivating factor for. <i>He <b>explained</b> the situation.</i>
<b>explicate</b>	Analyse and develop (an idea or principle) in detail. <i>These essays seek to <b>explicate</b> and contextualize Kristeva s writings.</i>
<b><u>explicit</u></b>	Of a person stating something in an explicit manner. <i>The arrangement had not been made <b>explicit</b>.</i>
<b><u>exposition</u></b>	(music) the section of a movement (especially in sonata form) where the major musical themes first occur. <i>We would have understood the play better if there had been some initial <b>exposition</b> of the background.</i>
<b>expository</b>	Serving to expound or set forth. <i>An <b>expository</b> prologue.</i>
<b>expound</b>	Explain the meaning of (a literary or doctrinal work). <i>He declined to <b>expound</b> on his decision.</i>
<b>instructions</b>	A manual usually accompanying a technical device and explaining how to install or operate it.
<b><u>interpret</u></b>	Give an interpretation or rendition of. <i>The evidence is difficult to <b>interpret</b>.</i>
<b><u>interpretation</u></b>	The action of explaining the meaning of something. <i>The <b>interpretation</b> of data.</i>
<b>mean</b>	Mean or intend to express or convey. <i>I only <b>meant</b> to help you.</i>
<b>rationale</b>	(law) an explanation of the fundamental reasons (especially an explanation of the working of some device in terms of laws of nature). <i>He explained the <b>rationale</b> behind the change.</i>
<b>separate</b>	A separately printed article that originally appeared in a larger publication. <i>Police were trying to <b>separate</b> two rioting mobs.</i>
<b>signification</b>	The message that is intended or expressed or signified. <i>The <b>signification</b> of Chinese characters.</i>
