Rabbit in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am rabbitting or rabbiting
You are rabbitting or rabbiting
He/She/It is rabbitting or rabbiting
They are rabbitting or rabbiting

Rabbit in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have rabbitted or rabbited
You have rabbitted or rabbited
He/She/It has rabbitted or rabbited
They have rabbitted or rabbited

Rabbit in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been rabbitting or rabbiting
You have been rabbitting or rabbiting
You have been rabbitting or rabbiting
He/She/It has been rabbitting or rabbiting
They have been rabbitting or rabbiting

Rabbit in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I rabbitted or rabbited
You rabbitted or rabbited
You rabbitted or rabbited
He/She/It rabbitted or rabbited
They rabbitted or rabbited

Rabbit in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was rabbitting or rabbiting
You were rabbitting or rabbiting
He/She/It was rabbitting or rabbiting
They were rabbitting or rabbiting

Rabbit in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had rabbitted or rabbited
You had rabbitted or rabbited
You had rabbitted or rabbited
He/She/It had rabbitted or rabbited
They had rabbitted or rabbited

Rabbit in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been rabbitting or rabbiting
You had been rabbitting or rabbiting
He/She/It had been rabbitting or rabbiting
They had been rabbitting or rabbiting

Rabbit in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I will rabbit We will rabbit

You **will rabbit** You **will rabbit** He/She/It **will rabbit** They **will rabbit**

Rabbit in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be rabbitting or rabbiting
You will be rabbitting or rabbiting
He/She/It will be rabbitting or rabbiting
They will be rabbitting or rabbiting

Rabbit in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have rabbitted or rabbited
You will have rabbitted or rabbited
He/She/It will have rabbitted or rabbited
They will have rabbitted or rabbited

Rabbit in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been rabbitting or rabbitting We will have been rabbitting or rabbitting

You will have been rabbitting or rabbitting You will have been rabbitting or

rabbiting

He/She/It will have been rabbitting or rabbiting

They will have been rabbitting or rabbiting
