|                    |                     |
|--------------------|---------------------|
| Infinitive         | <b>to raft</b>      |
| Present Tense      | <b>raft / rafts</b> |
| Past Tense         | <b>rafted</b>       |
| Present Participle | <b>rafting</b>      |
| Past Participle    | <b>rafted</b>       |

## Conjugate Raft

### Raft in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

| <b>Singular</b>        | <b>Plural</b>    |
|------------------------|------------------|
| I <b>raft</b>          | We <b>raft</b>   |
| You <b>raft</b>        | You <b>raft</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>rafts</b> | They <b>raft</b> |

### **Raft in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

| <b>Singular</b>             | <b>Plural</b>           |
|-----------------------------|-------------------------|
| I <b>am rafting</b>         | We <b>are rafting</b>   |
| You <b>are rafting</b>      | You <b>are rafting</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>is rafting</b> | They <b>are rafting</b> |

### **Raft in Present Perfect Tense**

| <b>Singular</b>             | <b>Plural</b>           |
|-----------------------------|-------------------------|
| I <b>have rafted</b>        | We <b>have rafted</b>   |
| You <b>have rafted</b>      | You <b>have rafted</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>has rafted</b> | They <b>have rafted</b> |

### **Raft in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

| <b>Singular</b>                   | <b>Plural</b>                 |
|-----------------------------------|-------------------------------|
| I <b>have been rafting</b>        | We <b>have been rafting</b>   |
| You <b>have been rafting</b>      | You <b>have been rafting</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>has been rafting</b> | They <b>have been rafting</b> |

### **Raft in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

| <b>Singular</b>         | <b>Plural</b>      |
|-------------------------|--------------------|
| I <b>rafted</b>         | We <b>rafted</b>   |
| You <b>rafted</b>       | You <b>rafted</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>rafted</b> | They <b>rafted</b> |

### **Raft in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was rafting**                      We **were rafting**  
You **were rafting**                You **were rafting**  
He/She/It **was rafting**        They **were rafting**

**Raft in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had rafted**                      We **had rafted**  
You **had rafted**                You **had rafted**  
He/She/It **had rafted**        They **had rafted**

**Raft in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been rafting**                We **had been rafting**  
You **had been rafting**            You **had been rafting**  
He/She/It **had been rafting**    They **had been rafting**

**Raft in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will raft**                      We **will raft**  
You **will raft**                You **will raft**  
He/She/It **will raft**        They **will raft**

**Raft in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be rafting**                We **will be rafting**  
You **will be rafting**            You **will be rafting**  
He/She/It **will be rafting**    They **will be rafting**

**Raft in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have rafted**

**We will have rafted**

**You will have rafted**

**You will have rafted**

**He/She/It will have rafted**

**They will have rafted**

**Raft in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been rafting**

**We will have been rafting**

**You will have been rafting**

**You will have been rafting**

**He/She/It will have been rafting**

**They will have been rafting**
