## Synonyms of "Ranger" as a noun (10 Words)

<b>commando</b>	A unit of commandos. A <b>commando</b> attack.
<b><u>curator</u></b>	A keeper or custodian of a museum or other collection. <i>The <b>curator</b> of drawings at the National Gallery.</i>
<b><u>custodian</u></b>	A person who has responsibility for taking care of or protecting something. <i>The <b>custodian</b> of the Great Seal in Canada is always the Secretary of State.</i>
<b>fire warden</b>	A fireplace in which a relatively small fire is burning.
<b>forest fire fighter</b>	Land that is covered with trees and shrubs.
<b><u>guardian</u></b>	A person who protects or defends something. <i>I am acting as <b>guardian</b> of my late brother's family.</i>



**keeper**

A bar of soft iron placed across the poles of a horseshoe magnet to maintain its strength.

*Hazelnuts are good **keepers**.*

**preserver**

A skilled worker who is employed to restore or refinish buildings or antique furniture.

*The Benedictines have been best known as educators and as **preservers** of antique texts.*

**protector**

A regent in charge of a kingdom during the minority, absence, or incapacity of the sovereign.

*Ear **protectors**.*

**texas ranger**

An official who is responsible for managing and protecting an area of forest.

## Associations of "Ranger" (30 Words)

### arboreal

Resembling a tree in form and branching structure.

**Arboreal** rodents.

### **bamboo**

The hard woody stems of bamboo plants used in construction and crafts and fishing poles.

A section of **bamboo** about four feet long.

### **batten**

Furnish with battens.

**Batten** down a ship's hatches.

### **botanical**

A drug made from part of a plant (as the bark or root or leaves).

**Botanical** garden.

### **bush**

Dense vegetation consisting of stunted trees or bushes.

They have to spend a night camping in the **bush**.

<b>cane</b>	A strong slender often flexible stem as of bamboos reeds rattans or sugar cane. <i>A <b>cane</b> coffee table.</i>
<b>deforest</b>	Remove the trees from. <i>404 000 sq km had been <b>deforested</b>.</i>
<b>dendroid</b>	A graptolite (fossil marine invertebrate) of a type that formed much-branched colonies, found chiefly in the Ordovician and Silurian periods.
<b>environmentalist</b>	A person who is concerned about protecting the environment. <i>The <b>environmentalist</b> movement.</i>
<a href="#"><u>fence</u></a>	Enclose or separate an area with a fence. <i>Walkers may find themselves <b>fenced</b> out of the moor.</i>
<b>forest</b>	Denoting an area that was formerly a royal forest. <i>A large tract of <b>forest</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>garden</u></a>	The flowers or vegetables or fruits or herbs that are cultivated in a garden. <i>They brought us tomatoes from their <b>garden</b>.</i>
<b>glade</b>	An open space in a wood or forest. <i><b>Glades</b> of birch.</i>
<b>grove</b>	Garden consisting of a small cultivated wood without undergrowth. <i>An olive <b>grove</b>.</i>
<b>guard</b>	The person who plays the position of guard on a basketball team. <i>The left <b>guard</b> was injured on the play.</i>
<b>hedge</b>	Hinder or restrict with or as if with a hedge. <i>He <b>hedged</b> at every new question.</i>
<b>hiding</b>	The state of being hidden. <i>He went into <b>hiding</b>.</i>
<b>house</b>	The people living in a house a household. <i>The museum <b>houses</b> a collection of Roman sculpture.</i>
<b>invulnerable</b>	Impossible to harm or damage. <i>No state in the region is now <b>invulnerable</b> to attack by another.</i>
<b>lodge</b>	Be a lodger stay temporarily. <i><b>Lodge</b> a bullet in the table.</i>
<a href="#"><u>park</u></a>	Maneuver a vehicle into a parking space. <i>A walk round the <b>park</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>plantation</u></a>	An estate on which crops such as coffee, sugar, and tobacco are grown. <i>New conifer <b>plantations</b>.</i>
<b>prairie</b>	A treeless grassy plain.



<b>protect</b>	Keep safe from harm or injury. <i>Weatherbeater <b>protects</b> your roof from the rain.</i>
<b>protecting</b>	Shielding (or designed to shield) against harm or discomfort. <i>A <b>protecting</b> alibi.</i>
<b>safe</b>	Strongbox where valuables can be safely kept. <i>You will be <b>safe</b> here.</i>
<u><b>shelter</b></u>	Provide shelter for. <i>The hut <b>sheltered</b> him from the cold wind.</i>
<b>table</b>	Multiplication tables. <i>More than 200 amendments to the bill have already been <b>tabled</b>.</i>
<u><b>warden</b></u>	The head of certain schools, colleges, or other institutions. <i>The <b>warden</b> of a nature reserve.</i>
