Infinitive	to rationalise
Present Tense	rationalise / rationalises
Past Tense	rationalised
Present Participle	rationalising
Past Participle	rationalised

# **Conjugate Rationalise**

## **Rationalise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I rationalise	We <b>rationalise</b>
You <b>rationalise</b>	You <b>rationalise</b>
He/She/It rationalises	They <b>rationalise</b>

## **Rationalise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am rationalising	We are rationalising
You <b>are rationalising</b>	You <b>are rationalising</b>
He/She/It is rationalising	They are rationalising

#### **Rationalise in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have rationalised	We have rationalised
You have rationalised	You have rationalised
He/She/It has rationalised	They have rationalised

## **Rationalise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been rationalising	We have been rationalising
You <b>have been rationalising</b>	You have been rationalising
He/She/It has been rationalising	They have been rationalising

## **Rationalise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I rationalised	We <b>rationalised</b>
You <b>rationalised</b>	You <b>rationalised</b>
He/She/It rationalised	They <b>rationalised</b>

#### **Rationalise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was rationalising	We were rationalising
You <b>were rationalising</b>	You were rationalising
He/She/It was rationalising	They were rationalising

#### **Rationalise in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had rationalised	We had rationalised
You had rationalised	You had rationalised
He/She/It had rationalised	They had rationalised

#### **Rationalise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been rationalising	We had been rationalising
You <b>had been rationalising</b>	You <b>had been rationalising</b>
He/She/It had been rationalising	They had been rationalising

## **Rationalise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will rationalise	We <b>will rationalise</b>
You <b>will rationalise</b>	You <b>will rationalise</b>
He/She/It will rationalise	They will rationalise

## **Rationalise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be rationalising	We will be rationalising
You <b>will be rationalising</b>	You <b>will be rationalising</b>
He/She/It will be rationalising	They will be rationalising

## **Rationalise in Future Perfect Tense**

#### **Rationalise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been rationalising	We will have been rationalising
You <b>will have been rationalising</b>	You will have been rationalising
He/She/It will have been rationalising	They will have been rationalising
