Infinitive	to re-engineer
Present Tense	re-engineer / re-engineers
Past Tense	re-engineered
Present Participle	re-engineering
Past Participle	re-engineered

# **Conjugate Re-engineer**

**Re-engineer in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense** 



Singular	Plural
I <b>re-engineer</b>	We <b>re-engineer</b>
You <b>re-engineer</b>	You <b>re-engineer</b>
He/She/It <b>re-engineers</b>	They <b>re-engineer</b>

## **Re-engineer in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am re-engineering	We are re-engineering
You <b>are re-engineering</b>	You <b>are re-engineering</b>
He/She/It is re-engineering	They are re-engineering

## **Re-engineer in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have re-engineered	We have re-engineered
You have re-engineered	You have re-engineered
He/She/It has re-engineered	They have re-engineered

## **Re-engineer in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been re-engineering	We have been re-engineering
You <b>have been re-engineering</b>	You have been re-engineering
He/She/It has been re-engineering	They have been re-engineering

## **Re-engineer in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>re-engineered</b>	We <b>re-engineered</b>
You <b>re-engineered</b>	You <b>re-engineered</b>
He/She/It <b>re-engineered</b>	They <b>re-engineered</b>

#### **Re-engineer in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was re-engineering	We were re-engineering
You <b>were re-engineering</b>	You were re-engineering
He/She/It was re-engineering	They were re-engineering

## **Re-engineer in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had re-engineered	We had re-engineered
You <b>had re-engineered</b>	You had re-engineered
He/She/It had re-engineered	They had re-engineered

## **Re-engineer in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been re-engineering	We had been re-engineering
You had been re-engineering	You had been re-engineering
He/She/It had been re-engineering	They had been re-engineering

## **Re-engineer in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will re-engineer	We <b>will re-engineer</b>
You <b>will re-engineer</b>	You <b>will re-engineer</b>
He/She/It will re-engineer	They will re-engineer

## **Re-engineer in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be re-engineering	We <b>will be re-engineering</b>
You <b>will be re-engineering</b>	You will be re-engineering
He/She/It will be re-engineering	They will be re-engineering

#### **Re-engineer in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have re-engineered	We <b>will have re-engineered</b>
You <b>will have re-engineered</b>	You <b>will have re-engineered</b>
He/She/It will have re-engineered	They will have re-engineered

# **Re-engineer in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Plural
We will have been re-engineering
You <b>will have been re-engineering</b>
They will have been re-engineering
