- *Able to be read or deciphered; legible.*
- *Easy or enjoyable to read.*
- *Easily deciphered.*
- *(of data or a storage medium or device) capable of being processed or interpreted by a computer or other electronic device.*



Synonyms of "Readable" as an adjective (18 Words)

absorbing	Capable of arousing and holding the attention. <i>An absorbing account of their marriage.</i>
clear	Clear of charges or deductions. <i>A bright clear flame.</i>
comprehensible	Able to be understood; intelligible. <i>An idea comprehensible to the average mind.</i>
compulsive	Caused by or suggestive of psychological compulsion. <i>This play is compulsive viewing.</i>
decipherable	Easily deciphered.
easy to read	Obtained with little effort or sacrifice, often obtained illegally.
easy to understand	Affording comfort.
engaging	Attracting or delighting. <i>An engaging smile.</i>

engrossing	Capable of arousing and holding the attention. <i>The most engrossing parts of the book.</i>
enjoyable	(of an activity or occasion) giving delight or pleasure. <i>The company was enjoyable.</i>
<u>entertaining</u>	Agreeably diverting. <i>An entertaining puppet show.</i>
enthraling	Capturing and holding one's attention; fascinating. <i>An enthraling best seller.</i>
<u>gripping</u>	Firmly holding the attention or interest; exciting. <i>A gripping TV thriller.</i>
intelligible	Able to be understood only by the intellect, not by the senses. <i>Use vocabulary that is intelligible to your audience.</i>
interesting	Arousing or holding the attention. <i>It will be very interesting to see what they come up with.</i>
legible	Capable of being read or deciphered. <i>The original typescript is scarcely legible.</i>
stimulating	Rousing or quickening activity or the senses. <i>A rich and stimulating working environment.</i>
understandable	To be expected; natural, reasonable, or forgivable. <i>Though his accent was strange the words were perfectly understandable.</i>



Usage Examples of "Readable" as an adjective

- *Readable* copies of very old newspapers.
- A code which is *readable* by a computer.
- A marvellously *readable* book.
