- *Able to be read or deciphered; legible.*
- *Easy or enjoyable to read.*
- *Easily deciphered.*
- *(of data or a storage medium or device) capable of being processed or interpreted by a computer or other electronic device.*

<b>absorbing</b>	Capable of arousing and holding the attention. <i>An <b>absorbing</b> account of their marriage.</i>
<b>clear</b>	Clear of charges or deductions. <i>A bright <b>clear</b> flame.</i>
<b>comprehensible</b>	Able to be understood; intelligible. <i>An idea <b>comprehensible</b> to the average mind.</i>
<b>compulsive</b>	Caused by or suggestive of psychological compulsion. <i>This play is <b>compulsive</b> viewing.</i>
<b>decipherable</b>	Easily deciphered.
<b>easy to read</b>	Obtained with little effort or sacrifice, often obtained illegally.
<b>easy to understand</b>	Affording comfort.
<b>engaging</b>	Attracting or delighting. <i>An <b>engaging</b> smile.</i>

<b>engrossing</b>	Capable of arousing and holding the attention. <i>The most <b>engrossing</b> parts of the book.</i>
<b>enjoyable</b>	(of an activity or occasion) giving delight or pleasure. <i>The company was <b>enjoyable</b>.</i>
<b><u>entertaining</u></b>	Agreeably diverting. <i>An <b>entertaining</b> puppet show.</i>
<b>enthralling</b>	Capturing and holding one's attention; fascinating. <i>An <b>enthralling</b> best seller.</i>
<b><u>gripping</u></b>	Firmly holding the attention or interest; exciting. <i>A <b>gripping</b> TV thriller.</i>
<b>intelligible</b>	Able to be understood only by the intellect, not by the senses. <i>Use vocabulary that is <b>intelligible</b> to your audience.</i>
<b>interesting</b>	Arousing or holding the attention. <i>It will be very <b>interesting</b> to see what they come up with.</i>
<b>legible</b>	Capable of being read or deciphered. <i>The original typescript is scarcely <b>legible</b>.</i>
<b>stimulating</b>	Rousing or quickening activity or the senses. <i>A rich and <b>stimulating</b> working environment.</i>
<b>understandable</b>	To be expected; natural, reasonable, or forgivable. <i>Though his accent was strange the words were perfectly <b>understandable</b>.</i>
