- *(psychology) being temporarily ready to respond in a particular way.*
- *Prompt willingness.*
- *Willingness to do something.*



Synonyms of "Readiness" as a noun (26 Words)

at one's fingertips	A highly unstable radioactive element (the heaviest of the halogen series); a decay product of uranium and thorium.
at the ready	100 at equal 1 kip in Laos.
eagerness	Prompt willingness. <i>They showed no eagerness to spread the gospel.</i>
enthusiasm	Something that arouses enthusiasm. <i>Enthusiasm for his program is growing.</i>
facility	Absence of difficulty or effort. <i>An overdraft facility.</i>
fitness	Fitness to traverse the seas. <i>A fitness test.</i>
forwardness	Prompt willingness. <i>I hope that my forwardness hasn't offended you.</i>

gameness	Disability of walking due to crippling of the legs or feet.
handy	United States blues musician who transcribed and published traditional blues music (1873-1958).
inclination	The action of inclining the body or head. <i>Cometary orbits vary widely in inclination.</i>
keenness	A quick and penetrating intelligence. <i>He has expressed his keenness to retain his job.</i>
on hand	One of two sides of an issue.
preparation	A substance that is specially made up, especially a medicine or food. <i>The resolution of one dissonance is often the preparation for another dissonance.</i>
preparedness	The state of having been made ready or prepared for use or action (especially military action). <i>The country maintained a high level of military preparedness.</i>
promptness	The quality or habit of adhering to an appointed time.
punctuality	The fact or quality of being on time. <i>He was a stickler for punctuality.</i>
quickness	The quality of being prompt to understand, think, or learn. <i>An athlete with outstanding quickness and agility.</i>
rapidity	A rate that is rapid. <i>Technology spreads with extraordinary rapidity.</i>
ready	Poised for action. <i>Their guns were at the ready.</i>
set	A group of things of the same kind that belong together and are so used. <i>A set of books.</i>
speed	The ratio of the focal length to the diameter of a (camera) lens system. <i>Wish me good speed.</i>
speediness	A rate that is rapid.
swiftness	Lack of delay; promptness. <i>The turtle ran on shore with remarkable swiftness.</i>
timeliness	The fact or quality of being done or occurring at a favourable or useful time. <i>Managers were happy with the timeliness of the deliveries.</i>
willingness	The quality or state of being prepared to do something; readiness. <i>He expressed his willingness to help.</i>

zeal

Prompt willingness.
*He felt a kind of religious **zeal**.*
