## Associations of "Realistically" (30 Words)

<b>anticipate</b>	Regard as probable; expect or predict. <i>They failed to <b>anticipate</b> a full scale invasion.</i>
<b>anticipation</b>	The action of anticipating something; expectation or prediction. <i>Her eyes sparkled with <b>anticipation</b>.</i>
<b><u>anticipatory</u></b>	In anticipation. <i>An <b>anticipatory</b> flash of excitement.</i>
<b><u>aspiring</u></b>	Directing one's hopes or ambitions towards becoming a specified type of person. <i>An <b>aspiring</b> artist.</i>
<b><u>assume</u></b>	Take on or adopt (a manner or identity), sometimes falsely. <i>She <b>assumed</b> indifference even though she was seething with anger.</i>
<b><u>assumed</u></b>	Adopted in order to deceive. <i>An <b>assumed</b> name.</i>
<b>assumption</b>	A thing that is accepted as true or as certain to happen, without proof. <i>Any society is built upon certain <b>assumptions</b>.</i>
<b><u>expect</u></b>	Consider obligatory request and expect. <i>The are <b>expecting</b> another child in January.</i>
<b>expectation</b>	A belief that someone will or should achieve something. <i>Reality had not lived up to <b>expectations</b>.</i>
<b><u>expected</u></b>	Regarded as likely; anticipated. <i>Write down your <b>expected</b> monthly income and regularly track your expenses.</i>
<b>feasibly</b>	In a way that possible or practical to do or achieve. <i>I ve learned a huge amount about what I could <b>feasibly</b> achieve in my next race.</i>
<b>forecast</b>	Predict or estimate (a future event or trend). <i>Coal consumption in Europe is <b>forecast</b> to increase.</i>

<b>foresee</b>	Be aware of beforehand; predict. <i>It is impossible to <b>foresee</b> how life will work out.</i>
<b>future</b>	Bulk commodities bought or sold at an agreed price for delivery at a specified future date. <i>Heaven and the <b>future</b> life with Christ.</i>
<b>guess</b>	An estimate or conclusion formed by guessing. <i>We can only <b>guess</b> at Alan's motives.</i>
<b>guesswork</b>	The process or results of guessing. <i>Answering this question will involve you in a certain amount of <b>guesswork</b>.</i>
<b>hopeful</b>	Feeling or inspiring optimism about a future event. <i>Two executive <b>hopefuls</b> joined the firm.</i>
<b>impersonate</b>	Represent another person with comic intentions. <i>It's a very serious offence to <b>impersonate</b> a police officer.</i>
<b>maybe</b>	Perhaps; possibly. <i>He was standing <b>maybe</b> 20 or 30 feet away.</i>
<b>occur</b>	Come to one's mind; suggest itself. <i>Precious stones <b>occur</b> in a large area in Brazil.</i>
<b>possible</b>	The highest possible score especially in a shooting competition. <i>Mickey scored the <b>possible</b>.</i>
<b>presume</b>	Suppose that something is the case on the basis of probability. <i>The argument <b>presumes</b> that only one person can do the work.</i>
<b>presuppose</b>	Require as a necessary antecedent or precondition. <i>This step <b>presupposes</b> two prior ones.</i>
<b>pretend</b>	Represent fictitiously as in a play or pretend to be or act like. <i>Dangling their legs in the water to catch <b>pretend</b> fish.</i>
<b>prognosis</b>	A prediction of the course of a disease. <i>It is very difficult to make an accurate <b>prognosis</b>.</i>
<b>prospect</b>	A place likely to yield mineral deposits. <i>His <b>prospects</b> as a writer are excellent.</i>
<b>putative</b>	Purported; commonly put forth or accepted as true on inconclusive grounds. <i>The <b>putative</b> author of the book.</i>
<b>sham</b>	Make a pretence of. <i>He was a <b>sham</b> totally unqualified for his job as a senior doctor.</i>
<b>simulate</b>	Reproduce someone's behavior or looks. <i>It was impossible to force a smile to <b>simulate</b> pleasure.</i>
<b>suppose</b>	Expect believe or suppose. <i>This step <b>presupposes</b> two prior ones.</i>
