<u>arena</u>	A large structure for open-air sports or entertainments. <i>He has re entered the political arena</i> .
department	A specialized division of a large organization. <i>He was a bit lacking in the height <b>department</b>.</i>
domain	An area of territory owned or controlled by a particular ruler or government. The French <b>domain</b> s of the Plantagenets.
<u>field</u>	The force exerted or potentially exerted in a field. A football <b>field</b> .
<u>kingdom</u>	A monarchy with a king or queen as head of state. The untroubled <b>kingdom</b> of reason.
land	Living or travelling on land rather than in water or the air. A <i>land</i> force.
monarchy	A state that has a monarch. The <b>monarchy</b> is the focus of loyalty and service.
<u>region</u>	The approximate amount of something usually used prepositionally as in in the region of. <i>The lumbar <b>region</b></i> .
sovereign state	A nation's ruler or head of state usually by hereditary right.
sphere	The apparent surface of the imaginary sphere on which celestial bodies appear to be projected. <i>He sometimes took out his telescope to make sure the <b>sphere</b>s were still revolving in good order.</i>

<u>archipelago</u>	An extensive group of islands. The Indonesian <b>archipelago</b> .
area	A subject of study. It was his <b>area</b> of specialization.
autonomous	(of a country or region) having the freedom to govern itself or control its own affairs. <i>The partitioning of India created two separate and autonomous jute</i> <i>economies.</i>
borough	A municipal corporation in certain US states.
<u>constituency</u>	A group of people with shared interests or political opinions. Most politicians are more interested in the voice of their <b>constituency</b> .
county	A sporting team playing for a county. <i>Administration at <b>county</b> level.</i>



demesne	Possession of real property in one's own right. A levy of one tenth on property in the royal <b>demesne</b> .
department	An area of special expertise or responsibility. Baking is not my <b>department</b> .
<u>district</u>	A division of a county or region that elects its own councillors. The committee <b>district</b> ed the city into blocks.
domain	An area of territory owned or controlled by a particular ruler or government. The French <b>domain</b> s of the Plantagenets.
equatorial	Of, at, or near the equator. <i>Equatorial</i> regions.
geographic	Determined by geography. The north and south <b>geographic</b> poles.
geographical	Determined by geography. <i>Geographical</i> research.
<u>geography</u>	The nature and relative arrangement of places and physical features. The <b>geography</b> of post war London.
littoral	The littoral zone. The <b>littoral</b> states of the Indian Ocean.
<u>local</u>	A local train or bus service. Migration can regulate the <b>local</b> density of animals.
locality	An area or neighbourhood. A working class <b>locality</b> .
municipal	Of or relating to the government of a municipality. International law only authorizes a belligerent to punish a spy under its <b>municipal</b> law.
municipality	The governing body of a municipality. <i>Voters in each <b>municipality</b> choose between four candidates.</i>
<u>neighborhood</u>	A surrounding or nearby region. My <b>neighborhood</b> voted for Bush.
northern	Situated in or oriented toward the north. A <b>northern</b> snowstorm.
peninsular	Of or forming or resembling a peninsula. The counties of <b>peninsular</b> Florida.
prefecture	The official residence or headquarters of a prefect. Enraged fans besieged the <b>Prefecture</b> of Police.



<u>province</u>	A territory outside Italy under a Roman governor. I made my way home to the dreary <b>province</b> s by train.
<u>region</u>	The approximate amount of something usually used prepositionally as in in the region of. <i>His work takes needlework into the <b>region</b> of folk art.</i>
regional	A stamp, newspaper, or other thing produced or used in a particular region. <i>Regional variations.</i>
southern	Situated in the south or directed towards or facing the south. <i>A</i> <b>southern</b> <i>exposure</i> .
subdivide	Divide into smaller and smaller pieces. <i>The cells <b>subdivide</b>d.</i>
territory	An area defended by a team or player in a game or sport. <i>Woodland <b>territory</b>.</i>
zone	Designate a specific area for use or development as a particular zone in planning. The land is <b>zone</b> d for housing.
