## **The Forms of Reappoint**

Infinitive	to reappoint
Present Tense	reappoint / reappoints
Past Tense	reappointed
Present Participle	reappointing
Past Participle	reappointed

# **Conjugate Reappoint**

#### **Reappoint in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>reappoint</b>	We <b>reappoint</b>
You <b>reappoint</b>	You <b>reappoint</b>
He/She/It <b>reappoints</b>	They <b>reappoint</b>

#### **Reappoint in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am reappointing	We are reappointing
You <b>are reappointing</b>	You <b>are reappointing</b>
He/She/It is reappointing	They are reappointing

#### **Reappoint in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have reappointed	We have reappointed
You have reappointed	You have reappointed
He/She/It has reappointed	They have reappointed

### **Reappoint in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been reappointing	We have been reappointing
You <b>have been reappointing</b>	You have been reappointing
He/She/It has been reappointing	They have been reappointing

### **Reappoint in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I reappointed	We <b>reappointed</b>
You <b>reappointed</b>	You <b>reappointed</b>
He/She/It reappointed	They <b>reappointed</b>

#### **Reappoint in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was reappointing	We were reappointing
You <b>were reappointing</b>	You were reappointing
He/She/It was reappointing	They were reappointing

#### **Reappoint in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had reappointed	We had reappointed
You had reappointed	You had reappointed
He/She/It had reappointed	They had reappointed

#### **Reappoint in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been reappointing	We had been reappointing
You had been reappointing	You had been reappointing
He/She/It had been reappointing	They had been reappointing

### **Reappoint in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will reappoint	We <b>will reappoint</b>
You <b>will reappoint</b>	You <b>will reappoint</b>
He/She/It will reappoint	They will reappoint

## **Reappoint in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be reappointing	We will be reappointing
You <b>will be reappointing</b>	You will be reappointing
He/She/It will be reappointing	They will be reappointing

#### **Reappoint in Future Perfect Tense**

#### **Reappoint in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been reappointing	We will have been reappointing
You <b>will have been reappointing</b>	You will have been reappointing
He/She/It will have been reappointing	They will have been reappointing
