# **Conjugate Rear-end**

## **Rear-end in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I rear-end	We <b>rear-end</b>
You <b>rear-end</b>	You <b>rear-end</b>
He/She/It <b>rear-ends</b>	They <b>rear-end</b>

## **Rear-end in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am rear-ending	We are rear-ending
You are rear-ending	You are rear-ending
He/She/It is rear-ending	They are rear-ending

#### **Rear-end in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have rear-ended	We have rear-ended
You have rear-ended	You have rear-ended
He/She/It has rear-ended	They have rear-ended

## **Rear-end in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been rear-ending	We have been rear-ending
You <b>have been rear-ending</b>	You have been rear-ending
He/She/It has been rear-ending	They have been rear-ending

## **Rear-end in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I rear-ended	We <b>rear-ended</b>
You <b>rear-ended</b>	You <b>rear-ended</b>
He/She/It <b>rear-ended</b>	They $\ensuremath{\textbf{rear-ended}}$

## **Rear-end in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was rear-ending	We were rear-ending
You were rear-ending	You were rear-ending
He/She/It was rear-ending	They were rear-ending

#### **Rear-end in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had rear-ended	We had rear-ended
You had rear-ended	You had rear-ended
He/She/It had rear-ended	They had rear-ended

## **Rear-end in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been rear-ending	We <b>had been rear-ending</b>
You <b>had been rear-ending</b>	You had been rear-ending
He/She/It had been rear-ending	They had been rear-ending

## **Rear-end in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will rear-end	We <b>will rear-end</b>
You <b>will rear-end</b>	You will rear-end
He/She/It will rear-end	They will rear-end

## **Rear-end in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be rear-ending	We will be rear-ending
You <b>will be rear-ending</b>	You will be rear-ending
He/She/It will be rear-ending	They will be rear-ending

## **Rear-end in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have rear-endedWe will have rear-endedYou will have rear-endedYou will have rear-endedHe/She/It will have rear-endedThey will have rear-ended

## **Rear-end in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been rear-ending	We will have been rear-ending
You <b>will have been rear-ending</b>	You <b>will have been rear-ending</b>
He/She/It will have been rear-ending	They will have been rear-ending
