Conjugate Rear-end

Rear-end in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I rear-end	We rear-end
You rear-end	You rear-end
He/She/It rear-ends	They rear-end

Rear-end in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am rear-ending	We are rear-ending
You are rear-ending	You are rear-ending
He/She/It is rear-ending	They are rear-ending

Rear-end in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have rear-ended	We have rear-ended
You have rear-ended	You have rear-ended
He/She/It has rear-ended	They have rear-ended

Rear-end in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been rear-ending	We have been rear-ending
You have been rear-ending	You have been rear-ending
He/She/It has been rear-ending	They have been rear-ending

Rear-end in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I rear-ended	We rear-ended
You rear-ended	You rear-ended
He/She/It rear-ended	They $\ensuremath{\textbf{rear-ended}}$

Rear-end in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was rear-ending	We were rear-ending
You were rear-ending	You were rear-ending
He/She/It was rear-ending	They were rear-ending

Rear-end in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had rear-ended	We had rear-ended
You had rear-ended	You had rear-ended
He/She/It had rear-ended	They had rear-ended

Rear-end in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been rear-ending	We had been rear-ending
You had been rear-ending	You had been rear-ending
He/She/It had been rear-ending	They had been rear-ending

Rear-end in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will rear-end	We will rear-end
You will rear-end	You will rear-end
He/She/It will rear-end	They will rear-end

Rear-end in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be rear-ending	We will be rear-ending
You will be rear-ending	You will be rear-ending
He/She/It will be rear-ending	They will be rear-ending
