Reason in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am reasoning We are reasoning
You are reasoning You are reasoning
He/She/It is reasoning They are reasoning

Reason in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have reasoned We have reasoned You have reasoned You have reasoned He/She/It has reasoned They have reasoned

Reason in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been reasoning
You have been reasoning
He/She/It has been reasoning
They have been reasoning

Reason in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Reason in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was reasoning We were reasoning
You were reasoning You were reasoning
He/She/It was reasoning They were reasoning

Reason in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had reasoned We had reasoned You had reasoned You had reasoned He/She/It had reasoned They had reasoned

Reason in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been reasoning
You had been reasoning
He/She/It had been reasoning
They had been reasoning

Reason in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will reason
You will reason
He/She/It will reason
They will reason

Reason in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be reasoning
You will be reasoning
He/She/It will be reasoning
They will be reasoning

Reason in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have reasoned We will have reasoned You will have reasoned He/She/It will have reasoned They will have reasoned

Reason in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been reasoning
You will have been reasoning
You will have been reasoning
He/She/It will have been reasoning
They will have been reasoning
