## Associations of "Reassuring" (30 Words)

<b>appeasing</b>	Intended to pacify by acceding to demands or granting concessions. <i>The <b>appeasing</b> concessions to the Nazis at Munich.</i>
<b>assist</b>	Give help or assistance be of service. <i>A senior academic would <b>assist</b> him in his work.</i>
<b>balm</b>	Used in names of other aromatic herbs of the mint family e g bee balm. <i>A skin <b>balm</b> for use after shaving.</i>
<b>calm</b>	The absence of strong emotions calm feelings. <i>Remained <b>calm</b> throughout the uproar.</i>
<b>calming</b>	The act of appeasing (as by acceding to the demands of.
<b>cheering</b>	Shouting for joy or in praise or encouragement. <i><b>Cheering</b> news.</i>
<b>comforting</b>	Providing freedom from worry. <i>We would like to thank our family and friends for their support and their <b>comforting</b> words.</i>
<b>compliance</b>	Excessive acquiescence. <i>All imports of timber are in <b>compliance</b> with regulations.</i>
<b>conciliatory</b>	Making or willing to make concessions. <i>A <b>conciliatory</b> approach.</i>
<b>conducive</b>	Making a certain situation or outcome likely or possible. <i>The harsh lights and cameras were hardly <b>conducive</b> to a relaxed atmosphere.</i>
<b>demulcent</b>	A medication (in the form of an oil or salve etc.) that soothes inflamed or injured skin.
<b>dulcet</b>	(especially of sound) sweet and soothing (often used ironically). <i>The most <b>dulcet</b> swimming on the most beautiful and remote beaches.</i>
<b>emollient</b>	Attempting to avoid confrontation or anger; calming or conciliatory. <i>A rich <b>emollient</b> shampoo.</i>

<b>encouraging</b>	Furnishing support and encouragement. <i>The results are very <b>encouraging</b>.</i>
<b>help</b>	A person or thing that is a resource that helps make something easier or possible to do. <i>There s no <b>help</b> for it.</i>
<b>helpful</b>	Providing assistance or serving a useful function. <i><b>Helpful</b> staff.</i>
<b>laxative</b>	A medicine which has a laxative effect. <i>The <b>laxative</b> properties of sodium sulphate.</i>
<b>meditation</b>	The action or practice of meditating. <i>A life of <b>meditation</b>.</i>
<b>offer</b>	The verbal act of offering. <i>The product is <b>offered</b> at a very competitive price.</i>
<b>ointment</b>	Semisolid preparation (usually containing a medicine) applied externally as a remedy or for soothing an irritation. <i>Scented <b>ointments</b> for the skin.</i>
<b>peaceful</b>	Peacefully resistant in response to injustice. <i>Everything was so quiet and <b>peaceful</b> in the early morning.</i>
<b>placating</b>	Intended to make someone less angry or hostile. <i><b>Placating</b> or placative gestures.</i>
<b>reassurance</b>	A statement that removes someone's doubts or fears. <i>We have been given <b>reassurances</b> that the water is safe to drink.</i>
<b>relaxing</b>	Reducing tension or anxiety. <i>A <b>relaxing</b> massage with aromatherapy oils.</i>
<b>relief</b>	A method of moulding carving or stamping in which the design stands out from the surface to a greater high relief or lesser low relief extent. <i>Employees who donate to charity will receive tax <b>relief</b>.</i>
<b>salve</b>	Apply salve to. <i>They <b>salved</b> my cuts and stopped the bleeding.</i>
<b>satisfying</b>	Providing abundant nourishment. <i>These are very <b>satisfying</b> books.</i>
<b>serene</b>	Calm, peaceful, and untroubled; tranquil. <i><b>Serene</b> skies and a bright blue sea.</i>
<b>soothing</b>	Freeing from fear and anxiety. <i>A <b>soothing</b> ointment for her sunburn.</i>
<b>unarmed</b>	(used of plants or animals) lacking barbs or stings or thorns. <i>Went alone and <b>unarmed</b>.</i>
