appeasing	Intended to pacify by acceding to demands or granting concessions. <i>The appeasing concessions to the Nazis at Munich.</i>
assist	Give help or assistance be of service. <i>A senior academic would assist him in his work.</i>
balm	Used in names of other aromatic herbs of the mint family e g bee balm. <i>A skin balm for use after shaving.</i>
calm	The absence of strong emotions calm feelings. <i>Remained calm throughout the uproar.</i>
calming	The act of appeasing (as by acceding to the demands of.
cheering	Shouting for joy or in praise or encouragement. <i>Cheering news.</i>
comforting	Providing freedom from worry. <i>We would like to thank our family and friends for their support and their comforting words.</i>
compliance	Excessive acquiescence. <i>All imports of timber are in compliance with regulations.</i>
conciliatory	Making or willing to make concessions. <i>A conciliatory approach.</i>
conducive	Making a certain situation or outcome likely or possible. <i>The harsh lights and cameras were hardly conducive to a relaxed atmosphere.</i>
demulcent	A medication (in the form of an oil or salve etc.) that soothes inflamed or injured skin.
dulcet	(especially of sound) sweet and soothing (often used ironically). <i>The most dulcet swimming on the most beautiful and remote beaches.</i>
emollient	Attempting to avoid confrontation or anger; calming or conciliatory. <i>A rich emollient shampoo.</i>

encouraging	Furnishing support and encouragement. <i>The results are very encouraging.</i>
help	A person or thing that is a resource that helps make something easier or possible to do. <i>There s no help for it.</i>
helpful	Providing assistance or serving a useful function. <i>Helpful staff.</i>
laxative	A medicine which has a laxative effect. <i>The laxative properties of sodium sulphate.</i>
meditation	The action or practice of meditating. <i>A life of meditation.</i>
offer	The verbal act of offering. <i>The product is offered at a very competitive price.</i>
ointment	Semisolid preparation (usually containing a medicine) applied externally as a remedy or for soothing an irritation. <i>Scented ointments for the skin.</i>
peaceful	Peacefully resistant in response to injustice. <i>Everything was so quiet and peaceful in the early morning.</i>
placating	Intended to make someone less angry or hostile. <i>Placating or placative gestures.</i>
reassurance	A statement that removes someone's doubts or fears. <i>We have been given reassurances that the water is safe to drink.</i>
relaxing	Reducing tension or anxiety. <i>A relaxing massage with aromatherapy oils.</i>
relief	A method of moulding carving or stamping in which the design stands out from the surface to a greater high relief or lesser low relief extent. <i>Employees who donate to charity will receive tax relief.</i>
salve	Apply salve to. <i>They salved my cuts and stopped the bleeding.</i>
satisfying	Providing abundant nourishment. <i>These are very satisfying books.</i>
serene	Calm, peaceful, and untroubled; tranquil. <i>Serene skies and a bright blue sea.</i>
soothing	Freeing from fear and anxiety. <i>A soothing ointment for her sunburn.</i>
unarmed	(used of plants or animals) lacking barbs or stings or thorns. <i>Went alone and unarmed.</i>
