Synonyms of "Rebuild" as a verb (8 Words)

reassemble	(of a group) gather together again. <i>The trucks had to be reassembled on arrival.</i>
<u>reconstruct</u>	Do over, as of (part of) a house. Later emperors reconstruct ed the army.
refashion	Make new. The industry reshaped and refashion ed itself.
<u>remake</u>	Make new. The bed would be more comfortable if it were remade.
remodel	Do over, as of (part of) a house. She remodel led the head with careful fingers.



renovate	Give new life or energy to. My wife wants us to renovate .
restore	Restore by replacing a part or putting together what is torn or broken. <i>Restore</i> the forest to its original pristine condition.
<u>revamp</u>	To patch up or renovate; repair or restore.



Usage Examples of "Rebuild" as a verb

- After the earthquake people set about rebuilding their homes.
- We try to help them rebuild their lives.
- The house was rebuild after it was hit by a bomb.





Associations of "Rebuild" (30 Words)

architect	A person who is responsible for inventing or realizing a particular idea or project. John was indisputably the architect of his own misfortune.
<u>architecture</u>	The style in which a building is designed and constructed, especially with regard to a specific period, place, or culture. Architecture and eloquence are mixed arts whose end is sometimes beauty and sometimes use.

fabricate	Concoct something artificial or untrue. You will have to fabricate an exhaust system.
ferroconcrete	Concrete reinforced with steel. A <i>ferroconcrete</i> storage tank.
forestry	Country covered by forests.
<u>forge</u>	A blacksmith's workshop; a smithy. He forge d ahead.
<u>planting</u>	Putting seeds or young plants in the ground to grow. <i>He ordered the planting of policemen outside every doorway.</i>
privatize	Change from governmental to private control or ownership. They were opposed to plans to privatize electricity and water.
recast	Cast again, in a different role. She had to recast her image to please the electorate in her home state.
reconstitute	Construct or form anew or provide with a new structure. The governing board was reconstitute d.
<u>reconstruct</u>	Reorganize (something. Later emperors reconstruct ed the army.
reconstruction	The action or process of reconstructing or being reconstructed. A reconstruction of the accident would be staged to try to discover the cause of the tragedy.
reestablish	Bring back into original existence, use, function, or position. <i>Reestablish</i> peace in the region.
reforestation	The process of replanting an area with trees. The need for post fire reforestation .
<u>refurbish</u>	Make brighter and prettier. The premises have been completely refurbish ed in our corporate style.
