## Synonyms of "Rebuild" as a verb (8 Words)

reassemble	(of a group) gather together again. <i>The trucks had to be <b>reassemble</b>d on arrival.</i>
<u>reconstruct</u>	Do over, as of (part of) a house. Later emperors <b>reconstruct</b> ed the army.
refashion	Make new. The industry reshaped and <b>refashion</b> ed itself.
<u>remake</u>	Make new. The bed would be more comfortable if it were remade.
remodel	Do over, as of (part of) a house. She <b>remodel</b> led the head with careful fingers.



renovate	Give new life or energy to. My wife wants us to <b>renovate</b> .
restore	Restore by replacing a part or putting together what is torn or broken. <i>Restore</i> the forest to its original pristine condition.
<u>revamp</u>	To patch up or renovate; repair or restore.



#### Usage Examples of "Rebuild" as a verb

- After the earthquake people set about rebuilding their homes.
- We try to help them rebuild their lives.
- The house was rebuild after it was hit by a bomb.





# Associations of "Rebuild" (30 Words)

architect	A person who is responsible for inventing or realizing a particular idea or project. John was indisputably the <b>architect</b> of his own misfortune.
<u>architecture</u>	The style in which a building is designed and constructed, especially with regard to a specific period, place, or culture. <b>Architecture</b> and eloquence are mixed arts whose end is sometimes beauty and sometimes use.

construction	The arrangement of words according to syntactical rules. She wore her hair in an amazing <b>construction</b> of whirls and ribbons.
creativity	The use of imagination or original ideas to create something; inventiveness. <i>Firms are keen to encourage <b>creativity</b>.</i>
downsize	Reduce in size or number. I <b>downsize</b> d the rear wheel to 26 inches.
fabricate	Concoct something artificial or untrue. You will have to <b>fabricate</b> an exhaust system.
ferroconcrete	Concrete reinforced with steel. A <i>ferroconcrete</i> storage tank.
forestry	Country covered by forests.
<u>forge</u>	A blacksmith's workshop; a smithy. He <b>forge</b> d ahead.
<u>planting</u>	Putting seeds or young plants in the ground to grow. <i>He ordered the <b>planting</b> of policemen outside every doorway.</i>
privatize	Change from governmental to private control or ownership. They were opposed to plans to <b>privatize</b> electricity and water.
recast	Cast again, in a different role. She had to <b>recast</b> her image to please the electorate in her home state.
reconstitute	Construct or form anew or provide with a new structure. The governing board was <b>reconstitute</b> d.
<u>reconstruct</u>	Reorganize (something. Later emperors <b>reconstruct</b> ed the army.
reconstruction	The action or process of reconstructing or being reconstructed. A <b>reconstruction</b> of the accident would be staged to try to discover the cause of the tragedy.
reestablish	Bring back into original existence, use, function, or position. <i>Reestablish</i> peace in the region.
reforestation	The process of replanting an area with trees. The need for post fire <b>reforestation</b> .
<u>refurbish</u>	Make brighter and prettier. The premises have been completely <b>refurbish</b> ed in our corporate style.
