<u>accede</u>	Take on duties or office. <i>He acceded to the post of director in September.</i>
accept	Make use of or accept for some purpose. What if Elizabeth accept ed Darcy the first time.
acceptance	A draft or bill of exchange that is accepted by being signed. You must wait for acceptance into the village.
accepting	Tolerating without protest. The atmosphere was judged to be more supporting and accepting .
acknowledge	Express obligation, thanks, or gratitude for. It is important to acknowledge the work of others in one s own writing.
acquire	Come to have or undergo a change of (physical features and attributes. You must acquire the rudiments of Greek.
acquirement	An ability that has been acquired by training. The acquirement of self control.
admissible	Deserving to be admitted. The tape recording was admissible as evidence.
<u>admit</u>	Declare to be true or admit the existence or reality or truth of. After searching for an hour she finally had to admit defeat.
admittedly	As acknowledged. Admittedly the salary was not wonderful.
adoption	The action or fact of choosing to take up, follow, or use something. <i>Private adoptions are illegal in Britain.</i>
<u>agree</u>	Show grammatical agreement. She s eaten something that didn t agree with her.
agreed	Discussed or negotiated and then accepted by all parties. Agreed in their distrust of authority.
annuitant	The recipient of an annuity.



compensation	The action or process of awarding compensation. The compensation of victims.
<u>concede</u>	Be willing to concede. In 475 the emperor concede d the Auvergne to Euric.
confess	Of a priest listen to the confession of. I must confess that I half believed you.
<u>consent</u>	Permission to do something. <i>He</i> consent ed to a search by a detective.
derive	Obtain. They derive d great comfort from this assurance.
<u>earn</u>	Earn on some commercial or business transaction earn as salary or wages. Through the years she has earn ed affection and esteem.
get	Take vengeance on or get even. You ll get used to it.
grantor	A person or institution that makes a grant or conveyance. Conveyed from grantor to grantee.
incur	Become subject to (something unwelcome or unpleasant) as a result of one's own behaviour or actions. People who smoke incur a great danger to their health.
obtain	Come into possession of. Adequate insurance cover is difficult to obtain .
permission	An official document giving authorization. They had entered the country without permission .
realization	Coming to understand something clearly and distinctly. <i>He did not live to see the realization of his dream.</i>
receptiveness	Willingness or readiness to receive (especially impressions or ideas. <i>He was testing the government s receptiveness to reform.</i>
recipient	Receiving or capable of receiving something. A recipient country.
resignedly	With resignation and acceptance; in a resigned manner.
take	Get into one s hands take physically. She take s Route 1 to Newark.
