## Usage Examples of "Recipe" as a noun

- bake** A social gathering at which baked food of a specified kind is eaten.

<b>broth</b>	A thin soup of meat or fish or vegetable stock. <i>In vitro cultures were established in MG3 <b>broth</b>.</i>
<b>cake</b>	(of a thick or sticky substance that hardens when dry) cover and become encrusted on (the surface of an object). <i>A fruit <b>cake</b>.</i>
<b>chef</b>	Work as a chef. <i>He <b>cheffed</b> on a yacht in the Riviera for two years.</i>
<b>cook</b>	Someone who cooks food. <i>I told you I could <b>cook</b>.</i>
<b>cookery</b>	The practice or skill of preparing and cooking food. <i>Italian regional <b>cookery</b>.</i>
<b>cooking</b>	Suitable for or used in cooking. <i>He developed an interest in <b>cooking</b>.</i>
<b>crispy</b>	(of food) having a firm, dry, and brittle surface or texture. <i><b>Crispy</b> fried bacon.</i>
<b>crust</b>	Form a crust or form into a crust. <i>A kindly old woman might give her a <b>crust</b>.</i>
<b>flour</b>	Cover with flour. <i><b>Flour</b> fish or meat before frying it.</i>
<b>fried</b>	Under the influence of alcohol or drugs. <i>A breakfast of <b>fried</b> eggs and bacon.</i>
<b>grill</b>	Cook food using a grill. <i>A <b>grill</b> pan.</i>
<b>johnnycake</b>	Maize flour bread typically baked or fried on a griddle.
<b>lasagna</b>	Baked dish of layers of lasagna pasta with sauce and cheese and meat or vegetables.
<b>noodle</b>	Informal terms for a human head. <i>Spicy Sichuan <b>noodles</b>.</i>
<b>oven</b>	An enclosed compartment, usually part of a cooker, for cooking and heating food. <i>Bake the dish in a preheated <b>oven</b>.</i>
<b>pan</b>	Wash gravel in a pan to separate out gold. <i>The camera <b>panned</b> across the room.</i>
<b>pasta</b>	A dish that contains pasta as its main ingredient.

<b>pizza</b>	A dish of Italian origin, consisting of a flat round base of dough baked with a topping of tomatoes and cheese, typically with added meat, fish, or vegetables. <i>A cheese and tomato <b>pizza</b>.</i>
<b>roast</b>	Of food having been roasted. <i>This is the <b>roast</b> most likely to be used in espresso.</i>
<a href="#"><u>sauce</u></a>	Provide a sauce for something season with a sauce. <i>Tomato <b>sauce</b>.</i>
<b>smoked</b>	(of glass) treated in such a way as to darken it. <i>A plate of <b>smoked</b> salmon.</i>
<b>soup</b>	Any composition having a consistency suggestive of soup. <i>We had to <b>soup</b> up the show for the new venue.</i>
<b>spaghetti</b>	Spaghetti served with a tomato sauce.
<b>stew</b>	Food prepared by stewing especially meat or fish with vegetables. <i>Beef <b>stewed</b> in wine.</i>
