## Associations of "Rectified" (30 Words)

<b>accustom</b>	Be used to. <i>I <b>accustomed</b> my eyes to the lenses.</i>
<b><a href="#">adapt</a></b>	Adapt or conform oneself to new or different conditions. <i>The policies can be <b>adapted</b> to suit individual needs.</i>
<b><a href="#">adaptation</a></b>	The process of change by which an organism or species becomes better suited to its environment. <i>The play is an <b>adaptation</b> of a short novel.</i>
<b>adaption</b>	The process of adapting to something (such as environmental conditions).
<b>adjust</b>	Adapt or conform oneself to new or different conditions. <i>A single control <b>adjusts</b> the water flow.</i>
<b>adjustment</b>	A small alteration or movement made to achieve a desired fit, appearance, or result. <i>Only slight <b>adjustments</b> to the boat are necessary.</i>
<b><a href="#">alter</a></b>	Make an alteration to. <i>The advent of the automobile may have <b>altered</b> the growth pattern of the city.</i>
<b><a href="#">amend</a></b>	Make amendments to. <i>A few things had gone wrong but these had been <b>amended</b>.</i>
<b>attune</b>	Accustom or acclimatize. <i>A society more <b>attuned</b> to consumerism than ideology.</i>
<b>convert</b>	A person who has been converted to another religious or political belief. <i><b>Convert</b> holdings into shares.</i>
<b>correct</b>	Socially right or correct. <i>The <b>correct</b> version.</i>
<b>disabuse</b>	Persuade (someone) that an idea or belief is mistaken. <i>He quickly <b>disabused</b> me of my fanciful notions.</i>

<b><u>edit</u></b>	A version of written recorded or filmed material made as a result of editing. <i>The footage wasn't good enough to be <b>edited</b> into broadcast form.</i>
<b>emend</b>	Alter (something that is incorrect). <i>The text was <b>emended</b> in the second edition.</i>
<b>emendation</b>	A correction or revision to a text. <i>Here are some suggested <b>emendations</b>.</i>
<b>fit</b>	The particular way in which something especially a garment or component fits. <i>A <b>fit</b> subject for discussion.</i>
<b>fix</b>	Decide upon or fix definitely. <i>Lupins <b>fix</b> gaseous nitrogen in their root nodules.</i>
<b>manually</b>	By hand rather than automatically or electronically. <i>Change channels <b>manually</b> rather than using the remote control.</i>
<b>metamorphose</b>	Change in outward structure or looks. <i>The salesman <b>metamorphosed</b> into an ugly beetle.</i>
<b><u>mistaken</u></b>	Wrong in one's opinion or judgement. <i>An unfortunate case of <b>mistaken</b> identity.</i>
<b>modify</b>	Transform (a structure) from its original anatomical form during development or evolution. <i>Please <b>modify</b> this letter to make it more polite.</i>
<b>modulation</b>	Alteration of the amplitude or frequency of an electromagnetic wave or other oscillation in accordance with the variations of a second signal. <i><b>Modulation</b> of the ray amplitude will result in sound being heard.</i>
<b>ratify</b>	Approve and express assent, responsibility, or obligation. <i>Both countries were due to <b>ratify</b> the treaty by the end of the year.</i>
<b><u>relevant</u></b>	Closely connected or appropriate to what is being done or considered. <i>The candidate's experience is <b>relevant</b> to the job.</i>
<b>reschedule</b>	Arrange a new scheme of repayments of (a debt). <i>The concert has been <b>rescheduled</b> for September.</i>
<b>retouch</b>	Give retouches to hair. <i><b>Retouch</b> the roots.</i>
<b><u>revamp</u></b>	Give new and improved form, structure, or appearance to. <i><b>Revamp</b> my old boots.</i>
<b>revisal</b>	The act of rewriting something.

**revise** Revise or reorganize especially for the purpose of updating and improving.

*The agency **revised** its procedures in as a result of the fire.*

**rightness** The quality or state of being best or most appropriate for a particular situation.

*They argue for the moral **rightness** of overthrowing the leader by force.*
