Definitions of "Redact" as a verb

definitions:

- Edit (text) for publication.
- Formulate in a particular style or language.
- Prepare for publication or presentation by correcting, revising, or adapting.
- Censor or obscure (part of a text) for legal or security purposes.

Form by pouring e g wax or hot metal into a cast or mold.

cast She cast down her eyes.

correct
The Council issued a statement correcting some points in the press reports.

Express (something) in language of a specified style. couch

Gold and silver threads **couch**ed by hand.

Be editor of a newspaper or magazine. edit

The story was ruthlessly **edit**ed down to its allotted span.

Make fixed stable or stationary. fix Harry s **fix**ed up a meeting.

Place a picture or photograph in a frame.

frame Frame a picture.

Put into a certain place or abstract location. put

We **put** the time of arrival at 8 P M.

Convert into direct current. rectify

His methods of **rectify**ing the cycloid.

Restore by replacing a part or putting together what is torn or broken. repair The new government moved quickly to **repair** relations with the USA.
