### Definitions of "Redact" as a noun

- *Someone who puts text into appropriate form for publication.*

### Synonyms of "Redact" as a noun (4 Words)

<b>redactor</b>	Someone who puts text into appropriate form for publication.
<b>reviser</b>	Someone who puts text into appropriate form for publication.
<b>rewrite man</b>	Something that has been written again.
<b>rewriter</b>	A person who revises or rewrites something.

## Redact as a Verb

### Definitions of "Redact" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “redact” as a verb can have the following

definitions:

- *Edit (text) for publication.*
- *Formulate in a particular style or language.*
- *Prepare for publication or presentation by correcting, revising, or adapting.*
- *Censor or obscure (part of a text) for legal or security purposes.*

## Synonyms of "Redact" as a verb (9 Words)

**cast**

Form by pouring e.g. wax or hot metal into a cast or mold.  
*She **cast** down her eyes.*

**correct**

Make right or correct.  
*The Council issued a statement **correcting** some points in the press reports.*

**couch**

Express (something) in language of a specified style.  
*Gold and silver threads **couched** by hand.*

**edit**

Be editor of a newspaper or magazine.  
*The story was ruthlessly **edited** down to its allotted span.*

**fix**

Make fixed stable or stationary.  
*Harry **fixed** up a meeting.*

**frame**

Place a picture or photograph in a frame.  
***Frame** a picture.*

**put**

Put into a certain place or abstract location.  
*We **put** the time of arrival at 8 P.M.*

**rectify**

Convert into direct current.  
*His methods of **rectifying** the cycloid.*

**repair**

Restore by replacing a part or putting together what is torn or broken.  
*The new government moved quickly to **repair** relations with the USA.*

## Usage Examples of "Redact" as a verb

- *A confidential memo which has been redacted from 25 pages to just one paragraph.*
