ameliorate Make (something bad or unsatisfactory) better.

The reform did much to **ameliorate** living standards.

Make something better improve.

The residents are mostly Londoners who have **better**ed themselves.

Make right or correct.

Engineers will work to **correct** the effects or air resistance.

To make better.

The weather improved toward evening.

make better Carry out or commit.



make over Organize or be responsible for.

mend Add fuel to (a fire.

Foot injuries can take months to **mend**.

Take apart (a piece of machinery or equipment) in order to examine it and

overhaul repair it if necessary.

Jodami **overhaul**ed his chief rival.

rebuild Build (something) again after it has been damaged or destroyed.

We try to help them **rebuild** their lives.

recondition Condition again.

A ship was being **recondition**ed.

Return to its original or usable and functioning condition.

Reconstruct the events of 20 years ago.

rectify Purify or refine (a substance) by repeated or continuous distillation.

Rectify the calculation.

redecorate Apply paint or wallpaper in (a room or building) again, typically differently.

You will have to **redecorate** the room afterwards.

refashion Fashion (something) again or differently.

The industry reshaped and **refashion**ed itself.

Make more precise or increase the discriminatory powers of.

Refine pig iron.

refurbish

Renovate and redecorate (something, especially a building.

The premises have been completely **refurbish**ed in our corporate style.

rehabilitate Help to readapt, as to a former state of health or good repute.

After a year in the mental clinic the patient is now **rehabilitate**d.

Make (something) again or differently.

remakeThe bed would be more comfortable if it were remade.

remodel Shape (a figure or object) again or differently.

We are **remodel**ing these rooms.

renovate Give new life or energy to.

My wife wants us to **renovate**.
