## Redo as a Verb

### Definitions of "Redo" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “redo” as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Make new.*
- *Do (something) again or differently.*
- *Do over, as of (part of) a house.*
- *Redecorate (a room or building).*

### Synonyms of "Redo" as a verb (20 Words)

<b><a href="#">ameliorate</a></b>	Make (something bad or unsatisfactory) better. <i>The reform did much to <b>ameliorate</b> living standards.</i>
<b>better</b>	Make something better improve. <i>The residents are mostly Londoners who have <b>bettered</b> themselves.</i>
<b>correct</b>	Make right or correct. <i>Engineers will work to <b>correct</b> the effects of air resistance.</i>
<b>improve</b>	To make better. <i>The weather <b>improved</b> toward evening.</i>
<b>make better</b>	Carry out or commit.

<b>make over</b>	Organize or be responsible for.
<b>mend</b>	Add fuel to (a fire). <i>Foot injuries can take months to <b>mend</b>.</i>
<b><u>overhaul</u></b>	Take apart (a piece of machinery or equipment) in order to examine it and repair it if necessary. <i>Jodami <b>overhauled</b> his chief rival.</i>
<b><u>rebuild</u></b>	Build (something) again after it has been damaged or destroyed. <i>We try to help them <b>rebuild</b> their lives.</i>
<b>recondition</b>	Condition again. <i>A ship was being <b>reconditioned</b>.</i>
<b><u>reconstruct</u></b>	Return to its original or usable and functioning condition. <i><b>Reconstruct</b> the events of 20 years ago.</i>
<b>rectify</b>	Purify or refine (a substance) by repeated or continuous distillation. <i><b>Rectify</b> the calculation.</i>
<b>redecorate</b>	Apply paint or wallpaper in (a room or building) again, typically differently. <i>You will have to <b>redecorate</b> the room afterwards.</i>
<b>refashion</b>	Fashion (something) again or differently. <i>The industry reshaped and <b>refashioned</b> itself.</i>
<b><u>refine</u></b>	Make more precise or increase the discriminatory powers of. <i><b>Refine</b> pig iron.</i>
<b><u>refurbish</u></b>	Renovate and redecorate (something, especially a building). <i>The premises have been completely <b>refurbished</b> in our corporate style.</i>
<b>rehabilitate</b>	Help to readapt, as to a former state of health or good repute. <i>After a year in the mental clinic the patient is now <b>rehabilitated</b>.</i>
<b><u>remake</u></b>	Make (something) again or differently. <i>The bed would be more comfortable if it were <b>remade</b>.</i>
<b>remodel</b>	Shape (a figure or object) again or differently. <i>We are <b>remodeling</b> these rooms.</i>
<b>renovate</b>	Give new life or energy to. <i>My wife wants us to <b>renovate</b>.</i>

## Usage Examples of "Redo" as a verb

- *A whole day's work has to be redone.*
- *The house is being redone exactly to suit his taste.*
