Definitions of "Redo" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “redo” as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Make new.*
- *Do (something) again or differently.*
- *Do over, as of (part of) a house.*
- *Redecorate (a room or building).*

Synonyms of "Redo" as a verb (20 Words)

ameliorate	Make (something bad or unsatisfactory) better. <i>The reform did much to ameliorate living standards.</i>
better	Make something better improve. <i>The residents are mostly Londoners who have bettered themselves.</i>
correct	Make right or correct. <i>Engineers will work to correct the effects of air resistance.</i>
improve	To make better. <i>The weather improved toward evening.</i>
make better	Carry out or commit.

make over	Organize or be responsible for.
mend	Add fuel to (a fire). <i>Foot injuries can take months to mend.</i>
<u>overhaul</u>	Take apart (a piece of machinery or equipment) in order to examine it and repair it if necessary. <i>Jodami overhauled his chief rival.</i>
<u>rebuild</u>	Build (something) again after it has been damaged or destroyed. <i>We try to help them rebuild their lives.</i>
recondition	Condition again. <i>A ship was being reconditioned.</i>
<u>reconstruct</u>	Return to its original or usable and functioning condition. <i>Reconstruct the events of 20 years ago.</i>
rectify	Purify or refine (a substance) by repeated or continuous distillation. <i>Rectify the calculation.</i>
redecorate	Apply paint or wallpaper in (a room or building) again, typically differently. <i>You will have to redecorate the room afterwards.</i>
refashion	Fashion (something) again or differently. <i>The industry reshaped and refashioned itself.</i>
<u>refine</u>	Make more precise or increase the discriminatory powers of. <i>Refine pig iron.</i>
<u>refurbish</u>	Renovate and redecorate (something, especially a building). <i>The premises have been completely refurbished in our corporate style.</i>
rehabilitate	Help to readapt, as to a former state of health or good repute. <i>After a year in the mental clinic the patient is now rehabilitated.</i>
<u>remake</u>	Make (something) again or differently. <i>The bed would be more comfortable if it were remade.</i>
remodel	Shape (a figure or object) again or differently. <i>We are remodeling these rooms.</i>
renovate	Give new life or energy to. <i>My wife wants us to renovate.</i>

Usage Examples of "Redo" as a verb

- *A whole day's work has to be redone.*
- *The house is being redone exactly to suit his taste.*
