### Definitions of "Referral" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "referral" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- A person whose case has been referred to a specialist or professional group.
- A person whose case has been referred to a specialist doctor or a professional body.
- The directing of a patient to a medical specialist by a GP.
- An act of referring someone or something for consultation, review, or further action.
- The act of referring (as forwarding an applicant for employment or referring a matter to an appropriate agency.
- A recommendation to consult the (professional) person or group to whom one has been referred.

Something that provides direction or advice as to a decision or course of

**direction** action.

A new council was installed under the **direction** of the king.

An act or instance of handing something over.

handover The handover of occupied territory.

passing on A bodily reaction of changing from one place or stage to another.



The action of assigning or directing something to a new or different place or **redirection** purpose.

Mail **redirection**.

The act of absolving or remitting; formal redemption as pronounced by a

**remission** priest in the sacrament of penance.

The scheme allows for the partial **remission** of tuition fees.

transfer

The act of transfering something from one form to another.

The best student was a **transfer** from LSU.
